State Health Society, Tamil Nadu – Strengthening of Government Hospitals -
Sanction of Funds – Orders Issued.

- 1) G.O. Ms. No.116, Health and Family Welfare (EAP-II) Department, dated 25.03.2011.
- 2) From the Mission Director, State Health Society letter No. 9900/S/SHS/13, dated 06.04.2014 and 05.08.2014.

ORDER:

The Mission Director, State Health Society in his letter 2nd read above has stated that it has been proposed to strengthen the infrastructure of Government Hospitals in the State under National Rural Health Mission (NRHM) and in this regard a detailed proposal has been included in the supplementary Project Implementation Plan (PIP) 2013-14 for the total cost of Rs.2,606 lakh. The National Project Coordination Committee (NPCC) of NRHM, New Delhi had approved the proposal and released a sum of Rs.781.80 lakh in the year 2013-14 being 30% of the total requirement of Rs.2,606 lakh. The balance fund has to be proposed in the PIP 2014-15.

2) The Mission Director, State Health Society has stated further that the proposal has been approved by the Executive Committee of the State Health Society in the meeting held on 08.10.2013. The various works identified by the Tamil Nadu Health Systems Project (TNHSP) are detailed in the annexure to this Government Order and these works are to be executed through Public Works Department (PWD). The Mission Director has stated further that the total cost of works to be taken is Rs.26,03,14,000/- as per the annexure and the balance amount of Rs.2,86,000/- (Rs.26,06,00,00 – Rs.26,03,14,000) to be utilized for provision of additional funds, if any arise in future for these works.

3) The Mission Director, State Health Society has also stated that the funds of Rs.781.80 lakh approved by the Government of India has been remitted to State Government account as per the G.O. 1st read above vide challan No.1699, dated 18.02.2014 at State Bank of India, Thousand Light Branch, Chennai. He has requested for strengthening the Government Hospitals as below:-

- i. The Mission Director, State Health Society, Tamil Nadu, Chennai is permitted to execute the various civil works in the Government Hospitals indicated in the annexure to this Government Order at a total cost of Rs.26,03,14,000 through the PWD.
- ii. The Mission Director is permitted to provide additional funds, if any required in future, by authorizing the Public Works Department to utilize the balance of funds Rs.2,86,000/-.
- iii. The funds of Rs.781.80 lakh approved for civil works and remitted to the Government account, sanctioned to PWD, for execution of civil works. The Engineer in Chief and Chief Engineer (Buildings), PWD, Chepauk, Chennai is permitted to issue orders to the Executive Engineers of the divisions concerned for the drawl of funds .
- iv. The Mission Director, State Health Society, is permitted to change the Hospitals for the construction of new buildings and cost of work on the basis of availability of site and local requirements subject to not exceeding total available funds.

4) The Government after careful consideration has decided to accept the proposals of the Mission Director, State Health Society and they accordingly issue the following orders:

- i. The Mission Director, State Health Society, Tamil Nadu, Chennai is permitted to execute the various civil works in the Government Hospitals indicated in the annexure to this Government Order at a total cost of Rs.26,03,14,000 lakh through the PWD.
- ii. Sanction is accorded to an amount of Rs.7,81,80,000 (Rupees Seven Crore, Eighty One Lakh and Eighty Thousand Only) to the Chief Engineer (Building), PWD, Chennai-5 for construction of various civil works in the Government Hospitals indicated in the annexure to this Government Order as per the authorization from the State Health Society.
- iii. The Mission Director is permitted to provide additional funds, if any required in future, by authorizing the Public Works Department to utilize the balance of funds Rs.2,86,000/-.

- iv. The Mission Director, State Health Society, Tamil Nadu, Chennai should take action to get the approval of the Government of India for the balance amount of Rs.1.824.20 lakh in the PIP 2014-15 for the above civil works and that send necessary proposals to Government for sanction of funds.
- v. The Mission Director, State Health Society is permitted to change the Hospitals for the construction of new buildings and cost of work on the basis of availability of site and local requirements subject to not exceeding total available funds.

5) The expenditure sanctioned in para 4 above shall be debited to the following head of account:

"4211-00-Capital outlay on Family Welfare – 103 Maternity and Child Health – Schemes in the Twelfth Five Year Plan –III Centrally Sponsored – SA – National Component – Reproductive and Child Health Project – 16 Major Works (DPC: 4211-00-103-SA-1608)
