ORDER:

The Mission Director, State Health Society in his letter read above has stated that the Central funds under the Centrally sponsored Schemes like National Health Mission are routed through the Treasury route as part of the State plan and requested to provide for central share of National Health Mission in the State Budget. The Government of India in their letter dated 21.08.2014 has transferred and credited a sum of Rs.3,00,00,000 into State Government account as its 75% share of Grants in Aid for the financial year 2014-15 for the implementation of the National Programme for Control of Blindness as mentioned below:-

The Government of India has requested to ensure 25% State contribution based on the release of funds by Government of India.

2. The Mission Director, State Health Society has further stated that the corresponding 25% of the State Share against the 75% of the Government of India release of Rs.3,00,00,000 (Rupees Three Crore only) works out to Rs.1,00,00,000 (Rupees One Crore only). Since Government of India has transferred the grants to State Government for drawal of amount through Treasury route from 2014-15, the amount of Central Share and State Share will have to be drawn from State Budget.

He has requested the Government to issue orders for the release of a sum of Rs.4,00,00,000 (Rupees Four Crore only) towards Central and State contribution of grants in aid to the State Health Society under National Programme for Control of Blindness for the year 2014-15 and to authorize the Mission Director, State Health Society and Project Director, Reproductive and Child Health Project, Tamil Nadu to draw a sum of Rs.4,00,00,000 (Rupees Four Crore only) under National Health Mission through Treasury mode.

3. The Government after careful consideration has decided to accept the above proposals of the Mission Director, State Health Society and they accordingly sanction a sum of Rs.4,00,00,000 (Rupees Four Crore only), i.e., Rs.3,00,00,000 (Rupees Three Crore only) being 75% of the Government of India grants-in-aid and Rs.1,00,00,000 (Rupees One Crore only) being 25% of the State share as matching grant to the State Health Society, Tamil Nadu to implement the National Programme for Control of Blindness for the year 2014-15.

4. The amount sanctioned in para 3 above is debit to the following Head of account:
