ORDER:

In the Government Order first read above, orders were issued sanctioning of an total amount of Rs.6446 lakh for the execution of civil works to the 26 District Head Quarters Hospitals for strengthening of infrastructure as approved in the 2nd Supplementary Record of Proceedings 2013 - 14 including the 12 bedded 'Burns ward' in Government Medical College Hospital, Pudukottai.

2. In the Government Order second read above, orders were issued permitting the Mission Director, State Health Society to utilize the State share of liquidation of arrears for infrastructure maintenance to the tune of Rs.4,65,25,000/- to complete the 23 pending civil works under National Health Mission including the above said 12 bedded burns ward in Government Hospital, Pudukottai.

3. In the letter third read above, the Mission Director, National Health Mission has stated that the among the various works sanctioned in the Government Order 1st & 2nd read above, 12 bedded burns ward in Government Hospital Pudukottai has not been taken up for want of additional funds. Now, the additional funds Rs.58 lakhs for the above said civil work have been remitted into Government Account, as the funds were previously released through remittance. However, with a view to rendering Health Services effectively, it has been decided that 12 bedded 'Burns ward' may be constructed in the premises of Medical College Hospital, Pudukottai, instead of Government Hospital, Pudukottai, as a new Medical College had been since established in Pudukottai.

4. The Mission Director, National Health Mission has therefore requested the Government Orders in this regard.
