ORDER:

In the Government letters first and second read above, a MoU each was executed with the Government of India for setting up of a Skill Centre in Coimbatore Medical College and Hospital, Coimbatore and Madurai Medical College and Hospital, Madurai, respectively, under Human Resource Development of Emergency Medical Services with 100% Central Government Share of Grants-in-aid of Rs.284.28 Lakhs for the following components:

- a) Building - Rs.1.10 crore (in existing Reinforced Cement Concrete (RCC) framed buildings) or Rs.1.40 crore (on terrace of existing buildings).
- b) Major equipments – Rs.1.31 crore
- c) Minor equipments – Rs.88.00 thousand
- d) Furniture – Rs.15.40 lakhs
- e) Consumables for training – Rs.3.00 lakhs
- f) Manpower – Salary of one course Co-ordinator at the rate of Rs.40,000/- (Forty thousand only) per month ie: Rs.4,80,000/- (Four Lakhs Eighty Thousand only) per annum for 5 years.
