ORDER:

In the Government Order first read above, orders were issued for the establishment of State Water Resources Management Agency (SWaRMA) as the State wide focal agency for environmentally and socially sustainable inter sectoral management based on the covenants of Agreement and Project Appraisal Document with the following objectives:

- To improve the Institutional arrangements and capacity for sustainable Water Resources Management in the State, and
- To develop and manage the Water resources of the State in holistic way in a river basin framework.

In the above said order, among others, it was ordered that the SWaRMA shall function with the following members:-

1.	The Chairperson	The Hon'ble Minister for Water Resources Department, (Public Works Department).
2.	Vice-Chairman	The Principal Secretary, Water Resources Department, (Public Works Department).

3.	Member	Engineer-in-Chief, Water Resources Department and Chief Engineer (General).

5.	Member	Chief Engineer, (Plan Formulation), Water Resources Department.
6.	Member Secretary	Chief Engineer and Director, (Institute for Water Studies), Water Resources Department.

In his letter third read above, the Engineer in Chief, Water Resources Department, Chennai, has stated that the State Water Resources Management Agency (SWaRMA) will have to function as a State level Advisory body to the Government and will recommend any Policy decision regarding water resources, water tariff, sectoral allocation for bulk users after consultations and for the development and maintenance of State Water allocation database with the following functions:-

- I. To advise the Government of Tamilnadu in water policies.
- II. To facilitate the development, dissemination and use of a comprehensive water resources knowledge base and analytical tools (including GIS and DSS) along with structured stake holder consultations, so as to develop sustainable and optimal resource development / sub basin frame work and management plans in river basin.
- III. To establish a planning and management framework for Water Resources in the Hydrological Boundaries of Water Resources Department and also to work in line with the compendium of rules in existence or to suggest modifications in the compendium of rules.
- IV. To advise in regulating water allocation for bulk users.
- V. To develop a State Water Allocation data base.
- VI. To prepare an annual water audit for each river basin in the State and to publish the same.
- VII. To review and approve State and river basin master plans and to appraise all surface water resources in the hydrological boundaries.
- VIII. To support and aid the enhancement and preservation of water quality within the State.

a). He has further stated that already a State level Water Utilization Committee is constituted with Secretaries of Public Works Department (convener), Industries Department, Municipal Administration and Water Supply Department, Agriculture Department, Managing Director, TWAD Board and with the Engineer-in-Chief, Water Resources Department, Chief Engineer, State Ground and Surface Water Resources Data Centre, Water Resources Department, Chief Engineer (Operation and Maintenance), Water Resources Department, Chief Engineer, Design Research and Construction Support, Water Resources Department, the Director of Agriculture, the Engineering Director, TWAD Board. Simultaneously a Technical Sub-Committee was reconstituted with the Engineer-in-Chief, Water Resources Department as the Convener and the Chief Engineer, Plan Formulation, Water Resources Department, the Chief Engineer, State Ground and Surface Water Resources Data Centre, Water Resources Department, the Chief Engineer, Design Research and Construction Support, Water

Resources Department, the Chief Engineer (Operation and Maintenance), the Regional Chief Engineers, Water Resources Department, the Chief Engineer and Director, Institute of Water Studies, Water Resources Department, the Chief Engineer, Agricultural Engineering and Chief Engineer, TWAD Board as members.

b). He has also stated that during the World Bank Implementation support visit (May 27-28, 2011), the team advised Water Resources Department to revise the composition of the Executive wing to include membership from other line Ministries as the mandate of SWaRMA and the same has been insisted during the Jan 23-27, 2012 Mission and recommends "the Government of Tamilnadu approve and sanction the membership of additional line departments to the Executive Wing at the earliest". In Tamilnadu it is proposed that the SWaRMA will act as a nodal Agency for the water sector in accordance with the Government of India's recent recommendation for establishment of water commission at the State level. In this role, SWaRMA will advise the Government of Tamilnadu on water policies in holistic river basin framework.

4. In his letter fourth read above, the Director, SWaRMA, has stated that the structure would be completed only after incorporating the following changes:-

1) The Administrative Committee may be renamed as State Water Committee with Chief Secretary as Chairman, with inclusion of Principal Secretary, Finance as also a member considering inter disciplinary approach needed for taking decisions.

2) The Committee comprising all the Head of Department may be named as Advisory Committee with Secretary, Public Works Department as Chairman and requested to approve the revised Organization Chart of SWaRMA.

5. The Engineer in Chief, Water Resources Department, has therefore requested the Government to approve the organization chart of SWaRMA as follows:-
