**ORDER:**

In the G.O first read above, orders were issued for creation of a pool of 'Licensed Surveyors' by Imparting Survey Training to Diploma holders in Civil Engineering. The Government have permitted to impart training to 100 Diploma holders per batch at the Survey Training Institute, Orathanadu for the purpose of issuing license in surveying.

2) In the letter 2nd read above, the Director of Survey and Settlement has stated that since around Rs.5.98 Lakhs Online Patta Transfer applications Involving Sub Divisions (ISD) are currently pending for disposal in Taluk offices across the State, in order to expedite the disposal of the pending applications, it was suggested to the Government to increase the in-take of candidates for the above licensing course to at least 150 persons per batch by imparting training to 50 more Diploma holders at Centre for Survey Training and Research (CSTAR), (Anna University) Chennai, in addition to 100 trainees at the Survey Training Institute, Orathanadu.

3) The Director of Survey and Settlement has further stated that the Centre for Survey Training and Research (CSTAR) was established through a Memorandum of Understanding (MoU) between Government of Tamil Nadu and Anna University in the year 2005. Survey training using traditional as well as modern survey equipments are being imparted to the staff of the Department of Survey and Settlement at Centre for Survey Training and Research (CSTAR). With the existing infrastructure available at Centre for Survey Training and Research (CSTAR), around 50 persons per batch can be given survey training.

4) The Director of Survey and Settlement has therefore, requested that the Government to issue orders for Imparting Survey Training to 50 Diploma holders in Civil Engineering (in addition to 100 Diploma Holders already permitted to be imparted training at Survey Training Institute, Orathanadu). Training in traditional as well as modern survey will be conducted at Centre for Survey Training and Research (CSTAR) for 2 months for every batch of Diploma holders. For the remaining 1 month, training will be given in Resurvey, in anyone of the places where resurvey is in progress. Selection of candidates (Diploma holders) for the above licensing course will be done centrally by the Principal/ Joint Director (Training), Survey Training Institute, Orathanadu and 50 candidates will be allotted to Centre for Survey Training and Research (CSTAR) for training (for 2 months). On completion of the training at Centre for Survey Training and Research (CSTAR), allotment of candidates to On-field Training in Resurvey and after successful completion of the course (3 months), 'License for Surveying' will be issued by the Principal/ Joint Director, Survey Training Institute, Orathanadu.

5) The Government after careful examination have decided to accept the proposal of the Director of Survey and Settlement and order for imparting survey training to 50 more Diploma holders in Civil Engineering (in addition to 100 Diploma Holders already permitted to be imparted training at Survey Training Institute, Orathanadu) at the Centre for Survey Training Research at the Anna University Campus in Chennai, subject to the modalities and procedure laid down in G.O.(Ms) No.362, Revenue and Disaster Management Department dated 04.10.2019.

6) The Director of Survey and Settlement is directed to pursue necessary further action with reference to the orders issued in para 5 above.
