ORDER:

The Hon'ble Chief Minister of Tamil Nadu has convened a Meeting with the Hon'ble Ministers and Senior Officers on 13.04.2017 in his chamber to review the drought situation in Tamilnadu. At the time of discussion, it has been decided to sanction a sum of Rs.100 Crores to combat drinking water supply in Urban and Rural areas and Rs.10.00 Crores to the Directorate of Animal Husbandry and Veterinary Services to ensure supply of feed concentrate, dry Fooder and water to the cattle from the State Disaster Response Fund (SDRF).

2. In the Government Order second read above, Government have sanctioned a sum of Rs.105.00 Crores (Rupees One Hundred and Five Crores only) from the State Disaster Response Fund (SDRF) for undertaking water supply works as per the guidelines of State Disaster Response Fund (SDRF) as applicable and necessitated by severe drought to the following departments as detailed below:-

3. In the Government Order fifth read above, the Government have sanctioned Rs.10.00 Crores to the Animal Husbandry and Veterinary Services department to maintain continuous supply of dry fodder to animals under State Disaster Response Fund (SDRF).

4. As per the announcement made by the Hon'ble Chief Minister on 13.04.2017, in order to combat Drinking Water Supply in urban and rural areas and to ensure supply of feed concentrate, Dry fodder and water to the cattle, the Government hereby sanction a sum of Rs.110.00 Crores (Rupees One hundred and Ten Crores only) from the State Disaster Response Fund (SDRF) to the respective departments as detailed below:-

7. The Principal Secretary/ Commissioner of Revenue Administration is also requested to utilize the above amount by adhering to the guidelines communicated by Government of India.

8. The Principal Secretary/ Commissioner of Revenue Administration is also requested to send the utilization certificates to Government immediately.
