Sub: Public Services – Tamil Nadu Civil Services (Disciplinary Proceedings Tribunal) Rules, 1955 – Enquiry by Tribunal for Disciplinary Proceedings – Framing of charges – Instructions issued- Reg.

It has come to the notice of the Government that in a Vigilance and Anti-Corruption case, which was remitted to Commissioner for Disciplinary Proceedings, charges have been framed in a single charge memo against the Delinquent Officers involved in that case.

- 2) Framing of charges in a single charge memo to all the delinquent officers involved in the same irregularity, may create complications in finalizing the disciplinary proceedings and may also invite unnecessary legal impediments.
- 3) Hence, the Government after careful examination instruct that all the Disciplinary Authorities should frame charges separately and issue the charge memo individually to the delinquent officers involved in the same irregularity.
