ORDER:

The Project Director, Tamil Nadu Health Systems Project in his letter sixth read above has stated that the World Bank supported Tamil Nadu Health Systems Project is being implemented from January 2005 and the Project closes on September 2013. The goal of the Project is to improve the Health outcomes of the people of Tamil Nadu especially the poor and disadvantaged. One of the objectives of the project is to improve the access and utilization of Health services by the poor people. Another objective is to strengthen the public health care facilities so that effective Health Care Service can be provided to the people accessing the services in Government Hospitals.

2. To achieve the above said objectives, the Government have created 3740 posts of contractual Staff Nurses in all hospitals including some Municipal hospitals and Primary Health Centres as detailed below.

The above said contractual Staff Nurses were paid monthly contract payment @ Rs. 3500/- for the first year, Rs. 4000/- for the second year and Rs. 5000/- for the third year. The contract payment of these Staff Nurses has been increased to Rs. 4000/-, Rs. 4500/- and Rs. 5500/- respectively for the first, second and third years of service in GO.(Ms)No.395, Finance (Salaries) department, dated: 14.10.2010.

3. In G.O (Ms) No.342, Health and Family Welfare Department dated:14.12.2012 fifth read above, contract payment of the contract Staff Nurses sanctioned under the National Rural Health Mission, has been revised from the existing rate of Rs.4000/-(first year) , Rs. 4500/-(second year) and Rs. 5500/-(third year) to Rs. 7000/-(first year), Rs. 7500/- (second year) and Rs. 8000/-(third year) respectively with effect from 1st April 2012.

4. The Project Director, Tamil Nadu Health Systems Project has therefore requested the Government to issue orders to enhance the contract pay of contractual Staff Nurses working in Comprehensive Emergency Obstetric and New Born Care Centres, Project Hospitals and Non Communicable Diseases Prevention and Treatment Programme in Government Hospital and Primary Health Centres under Tamil Nadu Health Systems Project as follows:

The Government after careful consideration has decided to accept the above proposal of the Project Director, Tamil Nadu Health Systems Project and accordingly, accord sanction for enhancing the contract pay of the contractual Staff Nurses working in Comprehensive Emergency Obstetric and New Born Care Centres, Project Hospitals, Non Communicable Diseases Prevention and Treatment Programme in the Government Hospitals and Primary Health Centres under the Tamil Nadu Health Systems Project with effect from 1st April 2012 as follows:
