



### **ABSTRACT**

### **ORDER:**

During the Collector's Conference held on December 2012, the Hon'ble Chief Minister has announced among others that in Thiruvannamalai, the 14 km Girivalam path will be developed by widening it and by providing emergency lanes.

2. The Chief Engineer(Construction & Maintenance) Highways Department in his letter read above, has reported that it is proposed to widen the existing road and provide footpath in the below said roads (Part-1,2,3,4,5&6) covering 14.00 Km of Girivalam path for the usage of the devotees and to avoid congestion to the regular traffic in Girivalam path as follows:-

**Part-1:** Widening & Improving Pandy- Krishnagiri road (NH 66, NHAI) Km 104/6- 105/6 with Foot path and storm water Drain and Culverts (Girivalam Path)

**Part-2:** Widening & Improving Pandy- Krishnagiri road (NH 66, NHAI) Km 105/6- 109/0 with Foot path & storm water Drain and Culverts (Girivalam Path)

**Part-3:** Widening & Improving Hill Round road (M660) Km 0/0- 5/2 with Foot path & storm water Drain and Culverts (Girivalam Path)

**Part-4:** Widening & Improving Tiruvannamalai -Kanji road (M 503) Km 0/0- 2/6 with Foot path & storm water Drain and Culverts (Girivalm Path)

**Part-5:** Widening & Improving Cuddalore- Chittoor road (SH 9) Km 108/4- 110/0 with Foot path & storm water Drain and Culverts (Girivalam Path)

**Part-6: Widening & Improving Tiruvannamalai -Avalurpet road (SH 133A) Km 0/0- 0/2 with Foot path & storm water Drain and Culverts (Girivalam Path)**

3. The Chief Engineer (Construction & Maintenance) Highways Department has also stated that the preparation of Detailed Project Report for the above work has been taken up under Revolving Fund. Sanction of funds for the preparation of Detailed Project Report is required separately to meet out the expenditure to be incurred for these works. The fund in BE 2013-2014 is Rs. 100 lakh only and expenditure incurred so far is Rs.50 lakh, therefore Revolving Fund is not sufficient to accommodate the ongoing Detailed Project Report works since this head is utilized by all wings of Highways Department.

4. The Chief Engineer (Construction & Maintenance) Highways Department has therefore requested the Government to accord administrative sanction for a sum of Rs.15.00 lakhs for the preparation of Detailed Project Report for widening and improving of 14 kms of Girivalam Path in Thiruvannamalai.

5. The Government after careful examination, accept the proposal of the Chief Engineer (Construction & Maintenance) Highways Department and accord administrative sanction for a sum of Rs.15.00 lakhs. (Rupees fifteen lakhs only) for the preparation of Detailed Project Report for widening and improving of 14kms of Girivalam Path in Thiruvannamalai Town. He is also directed to integrate the requirements of Hindu Religious and Charitable Endowments / Municipal Administration and Water Supply / Rural Development and Health etc, in the proposed Detailed Project Report

6. The expenditure sanctioned in para 5 above shall be debited to the following Head of Account:-

“ 5054 - Capital Outlay on Roads and Bridges - 80 General -004 –Research and Development-I – Non–Plan – AA – Investigation / Estimation of Project work under Roads and Bridges-16 Major Works”

7. Necessary additional funds will be provided in Revised Estimates/Final Modified Appropriation 2013-14 to meet the expenditure sanctioned in para-5 above. Pending provision of funds in Revised Estimates/Final Modified Appropriation 2013-14, the Chief Engineer (Construction& Maintenance), Chennai is authorized to incur the expenditure and he is requested to include the expenditure sanctioned above, while sending the Budget proposal for Revised Estimates/Final Modified Appropriation 2013-14 to Finance (PW-I) Department without fail.
