ORDER:

During the Budget Session 2013-2014, the Hon'ble Minister (Highways and Minor Ports) has announced as follows:-

“போக்குவரத்து நெரிசலை குறைக்கும் வகையில் காஞ்சிபுரம் மாவட்டத்தில் உத்திரமேரூர் நகருக்கு 4.20 கி.மீ. நீள புறவழிச்சாலையும் மற்றும் வாலாஜாபாத் நகருக்கு 3.40 கி.மீ. நீள புறவழிச்சாலையும் அமைக்க திட்டமிடப்பட்டுள்ளது. இதன் முதற்கட்டமாக நில எடுப்புப் பணிகள் 14.50 கோடி ரூபாய் மதிப்பில் மேற்கொள்ளப்படும்.”

2. In the letter read above, the Chief Engineer (Construction and Maintenance), Highways Department has reported that, Uthiramerur town is located at km 18/4 – 19/6 of Bukkathurai – Uthiramerur (SH-118) road. This is the important tourist place and important marketing centre for the adjacent villages. Uthiramerur – Kancheepuram (SH118A) road and Uthiramerur – Kammalampondi – Acharapakkam road (MDR) are originating from this town. Uthiramerur bus stand is located at km 18/10 of this road which creates more congestion of traffic. Bukkathurai – Uthiramerur road runs through the thickly populated built up area from km 18/4-19/6. The current PCU for the road is estimated as 17332 which exceed the capacity of two lane road. Many institutions and industries are located along this road. The available width of Right of way at km 18/6 – 19/2 is ranging from 12m to 9m with carriage way width of 7.00m and Right of way at km 19/200 – 19/470 is only 7.00m with carriage way width of 6.00m only. This road is

having two sharp 90° curves at km 19/4 & 19/6 which cannot be improved due to non availability of Right of Way as the Sub Registrar Office, Taluk Office, Sub Treasury Office, IOB etc., are located at this stretch. Due to the above reasons, it is absolutely necessary to provide a bypass for Uthiramerur town to avoid traffic congestion and also to save the time of crossing Uthiramerur town stretch. The proposed bypass road to Uthiramerur town branches at Km 17/7 of Bukkathurai - Uthiramerur road (SH118) and joins at Km 21/2 of the same road near Bukkathurai village as per the approval of the alignment committee. In order to carry out the work the land has to be acquired on either sides of the proposed alignment for 15.25 m each from the centre line, so as to have a Right of Way (R.O.W) of 30.50 m. The total area of land to be acquired is about 11.89 hectares. The total cost of land acquisition for "Forming bypass road to Uthiramerur town (Km 0/0-4/094)" is finalized for Rs.7.00 Crore after including Solatium at 30%, Additional market value at 12.0%, Advertisement charges and P.S and contingencies charges at 2.5%.

3. The Chief Engineer (Construction and Maintenance) Highways Department has, therefore, requested the Government to accord Administrative Sanction for land acquisition for the work of "Forming bypass road to Uthiramerur town (Km 0/0-4/094)" at a cost of Rs.7.00 Crore.

4. The Government after careful examination accept the proposal of the Chief Engineer (Construction and Maintenance), Highways Department and accord administrative sanction for land acquisition for the work of "Forming bypass road to Uthiramerur town (Km 0/0-4/094)" at a cost of Rs.7.00 Crore (Rupees seven crores only), subject to the condition that the proposed bypass to Uthiramerur Town can be shifted bit further on the northern side to serve the further purpose effectively.

5. The expenditure sanctioned in para 4 above shall be debited to the following head of account:-

"5054 – Capital Outlay on Roads and Bridges – 04 - District and other Roads – 800- Other expenditure – Schemes in the Twelfth Five year Plan – II - State Plan - JK – Acquisition of lands for Bypasses - 64 – Lands" (D.P.Code.5054-04-800-JK-6403).

6. The expenditure sanctioned in para – 4 above is an item of "New Service". The approval of the Legislature will be obtained in due course. Pending approval of the Legislature, expenditure will be initially met by sanction of an advance from the Contingency fund, orders regarding which will be issued by the Government in Finance (BG-1) Department separately. The Chief Engineer (Construction and Maintenance), Highways Department, Chennai is requested to send necessary proposal to Government in Finance (BG-1) Department, in the prescribed format along with a copy of this order for sanction of an advance required for the current year from Contingency Fund. He is also requested to send a draft explanatory notes for including the above expenditure in the Final Supplementary Estimate 2013-14 to Finance (BG-1) Department without fail.

7. This order issues with the concurrence of Finance Department vide its U.O.No.18/DS(NV)/13, dated 08.10.2013 and ASL No.1553 (One thousand five hundred and fifty three).
