ORDER:-

During the Budget Session held on 15-04-2013, the Hon'ble Minister (Highways and Minor Ports) has announced that "Formation Outer ring road for Erode Town (Phase III) Km 7/6-14/8 including Construction of Road Over Bridge will be taken up at a cost of Rs.65.60 crores"

2. In the G.O first read above, orders have been issued for sanctioning an amount of Rs. 22.00 crores towards land acquisition for formation of road from Kokkarayanpettai to Thindal for a length of 14.8 km .

3. In the G.O second read above, orders have been issued sanctioning an amount of Rs.14.00 crores for the first phase work of "Construction of High Level Bridge across Cauvery river between Kokkarayanpettai-Lakkapuram including approaches up to Karur road km 0/0-2/2" under CRIDP 2009-10.

4. In the G.O third read above, orders have been issued sanctioning an amount of Rs.12.00 crores for the second phase work of "Formation of Outer ring road from km 2/2 – 7/6" under CRIDP 2010-11.

5. The Chief Engineer (Projects) Highways Department in his letters fourth read above has reported that, Erode, the Headquarters of the Erode District is a fast growing industrial commercial city connecting the cities around, abounding with tannery, handloom and power loom industries. The Erode city is choking with heavy traffic which will become heavier in the longer run. If proper road development is not taken up systematically, the Erode City would get more congested. The stretch from km 7/6-10/8 starts at km 7/4 of Erode Kankeyam road and ends at km 4/8 of Erode Chennimalai road and the stretch from km 10/8-14/8 starts at km 4/8 of Erode Chennimalai road and ends at km 8/2 of Erode Perundururai Kangeyem road and this stretch also includes construction of Road Over Bridge at km 11/2-11/6 in Jeeva Nagar.

6. The Chief Engineer (Projects) Highways Department has therefore requested the Government, to accord administrative sanction for the third phase work of formation of Outer ring road for Erode Town from km 7/6-10/8 and the stretch from km 10/8-14/8 including construction of Road Over Bridge at km 11/2-11/6 in Jeeva Nagar at a cost of Rs. 69.30 crores.

7. The Government after careful examination, accept the proposal of the Chief Engineer (Projects) Highways Department and accord administrative sanction to a sum of Rs. 69.30 Crore (Rupees Sixty nine crores and thirty lakhs only) for the third phase work of formation of Outer ring road to Erode Town from km 7/6-10/8 and the stretch from km 10/8-14/8 including construction of Road Over Bridge at km 11/2-11/6 in Jeeva Nagar. The Chief Engineer (Projects) is directed to send the detailed estimate for the above works.

8. The expenditure sanctioned in para 7 above shall be debited to the following Head of Account:-

“5054 – Capital Outlay on Roads and Bridges – 04- District and Other Roads – 101 – Bridges – Schemes in the Twelfth Five Year Plan –II – State Plan –JE Construction / Reconstruction of Bridges – 16 Major works. (D.P.Code “5054-04-101- JE -1608”)

9. The expenditure sanctioned in para-7 above is an item of “New Service”. The approval of the Legislature will be obtained in due course. Pending approval of the Legislature, the expenditure will be initially met by sanction of an advance from the Contingency Fund, orders regarding which will be issued by the Government in Finance (BG.I) Department separately. The Chief Engineer (Projects), Highways Department, Chennai is requested to send necessary proposal to Government in Finance (BG.I) Department, in the prescribed format along with a copy of this order for sanction of an advance required for the current year from Contingency Fund. He is also requested to send a draft explanatory notes for including the above expenditure in the first Supplementary Estimate 2013-14 to Finance (BG.I) Department without fail.

10. This order issues with the concurrence of Finance Department vide its U.O No. 55552/PW-I-13, dated 15-10-2013 and ASL No. 1655. (One thousand six hundred and fifty five)
