The following Notification will be published in the Tamilnadu Government Gazette.

NOTIFICATION

Whereas all Cooperative Societies registered under the Tamilnadu Cooperative societies Act, 1983 engaged in Procurement, Storage and distribution of essential commodities were declared to be a public utility service for the purpose of the Industrial Disputes Act, 1947(Central Act XIV of 1947), for a period of six months up to and inclusive of the 22.08.2001 in the Labour and Employment Department Notification No.II(2)/LE/636/2001, dated the 02.08.2001 published at page 318 of Part II-Section 2 of the Tamilnadu Government Gazette, dated the 22nd August 2001.

And whereas, the Governor of Tamilnadu is of opinion that public interest requires the extension of the said period for a further period of six months;

Now, therefore, in exercise of powers conferred by sub-clause (vi) of clause (n) of section 2 read with the proviso there too of the said Act, the Governor of Tamilnadu hereby extends the period specified above for a further period of six months

commencing from the date of publication of the Notification in the Tamilnadu Government Gazette.
