ORDER

In the notification 1st read above, the Government of India have notified the recommendations of the Majithia Wage Boards for Working Journalists and Non-Journalist Newspaper Employees in Newspaper Establishments (other than news agencies), subject to the decision of the Honorable Supreme Court of India in W.P.(C)No.246/2011.

2. In the letter 3rd read above, Ministry of Labour and Employment, Government of India has requested the State Governments to create Special Cells to oversee the progress of implementation, Constitute Tripartite Monitoring Committee and gear up the State Labour Enforcement Machinery to ensure speedy and prompt implementation of the recommendations of the Wage Boards.

- 3. In the Government letter 4th read above, the Commissioner of Labour, Chenna-6 has been requested to take necessary action for implementation of recommendations of Majithia Wage Boards.
- 4. In the letter 5th read above, the Commissioner of Labour recommended the Government, to constitute a Special Cell under the Chairmanship of Joint Commissioner of Labour (Conciliation) with four Zonal Joint Commissioners of Labour and Public Relation Officer as members at the State Level in order to monitor the implementation of the recommendation of the Wage Board.
- 5. After careful examination, the Government decided to implement the recommendations of Majithia Wage Boards for Working Journalists and Non-Journalist Newspaper employees, as notified in the extraordinary Gazette of India, read in the reference first cited, subject to the outcome of the W.P.(C)No.246/2011 pending before the Hon'ble Supreme Court of India. Further, the Government constitutes a special cell to oversee and monitor the recommendations of the above wage boards with the following officials:-

Joint Commissioner of Labour Chairman (Conciliation) Joint Commissioner of Labour Member (Chennai Zone) Joint Commissioner of Labour Member (Thiruchirappalli Zone) Joint Commissioner of Labour Member (Madurai Zone) Joint Commissioner of Labour Member (Coimbatore Zone) Public relation officer of Labour Member Department

6. The Commissioner of Labour, Chennai-6 is instructed to constitute a Tripartite Monitoring Committee and gear up the State Labour enforcement machinery to ensure speedy and prompt implementation of the recommendation of the wage boards and to furnish quarterly progress report on implementation of

recommendations of Wage Boards for Working Journalists and Non-Journalist Newspaper Employees directly to Ministry of Labour and Employment, Government of India, under intimation to this Government.
