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### **ORDER:**

The Hon'ble Minister for Labour while moving this Department's Demand for the year 2012-2013, on the floor of Assembly on 11.05.2012, has made an announcement that a New ESI Dispensary will be established at Cheyyar area.

2. In the letter read above, the Director of Medical and Rural Health Services (ESIS), has sent the proposal for implementation of Employees State Insurance Scheme to Cheyyar area in Cheyyar Taluk, Thiruvannamalai District by setting up of a 'three doctor type' Employees State Insurance Dispensary, as per the Survey Report of the Additional Commissioner, ESI Corporation, Chennai and Feasibility Report of the Regional Administrative Medical Officer, Salem.

3. The Government after careful examination, accept the proposal of the Director of Medical and Rural Health Services (ESIS) and sanction the implementation of Employees State Insurance Scheme to Cheyyar area in Cheyyar Taluk, Thiruvannamalai District by setting up of 'three doctor type' Employees State Insurance Dispensary at Cheyyar.

4. Sanction is also accorded for the redeployment of the following 9 posts found in excess in the identified ESI Dispensaries in Chennai Region as per decision of the "Verification Committee":-

8. The facilities like specialist treatment, hospitalization, laboratory test, X-ray etc., would be made available by way of referring the beneficiaries to the Government Hospital, Cheyyar and Government Hed Quarters Hospital, Kancheepuram and Thiruvannamalai.

10. The expenditure sanctioned in para 7 above shall constitute an item of “New Instrument of Service”. The approval of the Legislature will be obtained in due course. Pending approval of the Legislature the expenditure may initially be met from an advance drawn from Contingency Fund regarding which, orders will be issued separately in Finance(BG I) department. The Director of Medical and Rural Health Services(ESIS) is directed to apply for sanction of Contingency Fund in the prescribed format along with the copy of this order to Government in Finance (BG I) department. The Director of Medical and Rural Health Services (ESI) is also directed to send necessary notes to Government in Finance Department for inclusion of the expenditure in the Supplementary Estimates to obtain the approval of the Legislature at the appropriate time.

11. The expenditure will be initially incurred by the State Government out of the Budgetary provision for 2012-2013 and fully reimbursed from the Employees State Insurance Corporation for the first three year period, from the date of implementation of Employees State Insurance Scheme in the above area and thereafter, the expenditure shall be shared between the Employees State Insurance Corporation and the State Government in the agreed ratio of 7:1.

12. The formal Notification under Section 1(3) of the Employees State Insurance Act, 1948, fixing the date from which the medical facilities shall be extended to the Insured Persons and their families in the above area will be issued by the Central Government.

13. The Director of Medical and Rural Health Services(ESIS) shall suggest immediately a suitable date for the extension of the Employees State Insurance Scheme to the above area after making all the medical arrangements in the said dispensary in consultation with the Regional Director, Employees State Insurance Corporation, Chennai.
