NOTIFICATION

In exercise of the powers conferred by Clause (B) of Sub-clause(3) of Section 1 of the Tamil Nadu Shops and Establishments Act, 1947 (Tamil Nadu Act XXXVI of 1947), the Governor of Tamil Nadu, hereby directs that all the provisions of the said Act shall come into force in the areas within the jurisdiction of the Village Panchayats specified in column(1) of the Table below in the taluks and district specified in the corresponding entries in Columns (2) and (3) thereof with effect from 1.3.1998.

The following Act of the Tamil Nadu Legislative Assembly received the assent of the Governor on the 16th June 1999 and is hereby published for general informations:-

ACT NO.18 of 1999

An Act further to amend the Tamil Nadu Shops and Establishments Act, 1947.

Be it enacted by the Legislative Assembly of the State of Tamil Nadu in the Fiftieth year of the Republic of India as follows:-

1) (1) This Act may be called the Tamil Nadu Shops and Establishments (Amendment) Act, 1999.

Short title

and commencement.

- 2) It shall come into force on such date as the State Government may by notification appoint.
- 2. After section 46 of the Tamilnadu Shops and Establishments Act, 1947 the following section shall be inserted namely:

Insertion of new Section 46-A

"46-A. Compounding of offences (1) Any offence punishable under Section 45 or any rule made under Section 49 may, either before or after the institution of the prosecution, be compounded by the Commissioner of Labour or such other officer as may be authorised in this behalf by the Commissioner of Labour, on payment, for credit to the State Government, of such sum as the Commissioner of Labour or such other officer may specify:

Provided that such sum shall not, in any case, exceed the maximum amount of the fine which may be imposed under this Act for the offcence so compounded.

(2) Nothing contained in sub-section (1) shall apply to a person who commits the same or similar offence within a period of three years from the date on which the first offence, committed by him, was compounded.

Explanation – For the purpose of this sub-section, any second or subsequent offence committed after the expiry of a period of three years from the date on which the offence was previously compounded, shall be deemed to be a first offence.

- (3) Where an offence has been compounded under sub-section (1) no proceeding or further proceeding, as the case may be, shall be taken against the offender, in respect of the offence so compounded and the offender, if in custody, shall be discharge forthwith.
- (4) No offence punishable under this Act shall be compounded except as provided by this Section.
