ORDER:

Section 41-A of the Factories Act, 1948 stipulates that the Government may appoint a Site Appraisal Committee for the purpose of advising the Government to consider applications for grant of permission for the initial licence of a factory involving a hazardous process or for the expansion of any such factory.

- 2. Accordingly, in G.O.Ms.No. 44 Labour and employment Department, dated 7.3.2000, the Government have reconstituted the site appraisal Committee with the term of a period of 5 years and the term of the said Committee expired on 6.3.2005. The Chief Inspector of Factories has, therefore, submitted proposals to the Government to reconstitute the Site Appraisal Committee.
- 3. In this connection, the Chief Inspector of Factories has stated that the Government have reconstituted the Site Appraisal Committee for a term of 5 years. As the tenure of the committee has expired on 6.3.2005, it is necessary to reconstitute the committee for a further period of 5 years as stipulated under section 41-A of the Factories Act, 1948 read with Rule 61-Q of the Tamil Nadu Factories Rules 1950

4. The Government, after careful examination, have decided to reconstitute the Site Appraisal Committee for a period of 5 years with the following as Chairman and Members:
