ORDER:

The Integrated Housing Scheme for Beedi Workers is implemented in this State with Central Government subsidy of Rs. 20,000/- and the State subsidy of Rs. 5,000/- per house. The Ministry of Labour, Government of India in their letters first and third second read above have granted administrative approval for construction of a total number of 1285 houses. Out of which the State Government have already released State subsidy of Rs. 18.75 lakhs for construction of 375 houses at the rate of Rs. 5,000/- per house vide Government Order second read above.

2. The Commissioner of Labour in his letter fourth read above has submitted the proposals for sanction of Rs.6,20,000/- for construction of another 124 houses for Beedi Workers from out of the 1285 houses for which Government of India has accorded approval as detailed below:-

3.The Government after careful consideration accept the proposal of the Commissioner of Labour and accordingly sanction a sum of Rs. 6,20,000/- (Rupees six lakhs and twenty thousand only) towards State Government's subsidy for construction of 124 houses for beedi workers at the rate of Rs. 5,000/- per house.

4.The amount sanctioned in Para 3 above shall be debited to the following head of account:-

"2230-Labour and Employment -01-Labour -109 Beedi Workers Welfare - Schemes in the Tenth Five Year Plan - IV Scheme shared between State and Centre - UB - Grants for Subsidy Beedi Workers for 'Build your own house scheme' Housing Scheme - 09 - Grants in aid -03 Grants for specified schemes " (DPC 2230-01-109-UB 0934).

5. The Commissioner of Labour, Chennai-6 is the estimating reconciling and controlling officer in respect of the above head of account. The Administrative Officer, (Minimum Wages), Office of the Commissioner of Labour, Chennai-6 is authorised to draw and disburse the amount to the beneficiaries.
