# ORDER:

Whereas the State Government are satisfied that the leave rules applicable to the workers of the factory, "Tamil Nadu Co-operative Marketing Federation Limited, Chennai-18 are not less favourable than these for which Chapter VIII of the Factories Act 1948, (Central Act LXIII of 1948) makes provision.

Now, therefore, in exercise of the powers conferred by section 84 of the said Act, the Governor of Tamil Nadu hereby exempts the said "Tamil Nadu Cooperative Marketing Federation Limited, Chennai-18" from the provision of section 79 to 82 of the Factories Act subject to the conditions that if any of the provisions made in the leave rules of the said Tamil Nadu Co-operative Marketing Federation Limited, Chennai-18 is not observed this order shall be deemed to have been revoked.
