ORDER:

The Government sanction the implementation of ESI Scheme to Madurai suburbs area comprising the Revenue villages: Vadapalanchi and Karadipatti by attaching the Insured Persons therein with the existing dispensary Ponnagaram.

2. Sanction is also accorded for incurring a recurring expenditure not exceeding a sum of Rs.23,990/- (Rupees twenty four thousand Nine Hundred and ninety only) towards provision of medicines to these employees and their family members.

3.The Specialists and Hospitalisation arrangement for the ESI beneficiaries in the above area would be made available to the employees and their families by way of referring the beneficiaries to the ESI Hospital, Madurai.

1. The expenditure shall be debited to the head of account:-

“2210 Medical and Public Health – 01 Urban Health Services-Allopathy – 102 ESI Scheme-I Non Plan – AG Expenditure on ESI Scheme covering both Insured Persons and their families-66 Medicines (D.P.Code No.2210 01 102 AG 6605)”

This expenditure may initially be incurred by the State Government and fully reimbursed later by the ESI Corporation for a period of three years from the date of implementation of ESI Scheme in the above area. Thereafter, the expenditure shall be shared between the State Government and the ESI Corporation in the agreed ratio of 1:7 within the overall ceiling.

5.The expenditure sanctioned in para 2 will be met within the funds provided in BE 2002-2003.

6.The Director of Medical and Rural Health Services (ESI) shall watch the receipt of assistance due to the State fully on credit to the State Government account under the relevant head of account promptly by preferring the claims correctly.

7. The formal Notification under Section 1(3) of the ESI Act,1948 fixing the date from which the medical facilities shall be extended to the Insured Persons and their families in the above areas will be issued by the Government of India. The Director of Medical and Rural Health Services (ESI) shall suggest a suitable date for the extension of the ESI Scheme to the above area in consultation with the Regional Director, ESI Corporation, Chennai-34.
