

ABSTRACT

Employment and Training Department – Training Wing – Starting of a new Government Industrial Training Institute at Andimadam Block in Perambalur District – Orders – Issued.

From the Special Commissioner and Commissioner of Employment and Training, Chennai-32 letter No. Plan 3/13385/2007 dated 13.3.2007 and 22.5.2007.

ORDER:

An announcement was made by the Honorable Minister for Finance on the floor of the Tamil Nadu Legislative Assembly on 28.3.2007 during the Budget Speech for the year 2007-2008 that,

"With a view to ensuring that the local youth get the benefit of the employment opportunities generated by the Special Economic Zone to be established in Perambalur district, two new Government Industrial Training Institutes will be set up in that district and a new Government Industrial Training Institute will be started in Sivagangai district next year".

2. The Special Commissioner and Commissioner of Employment and Training in the letters read above, has sent proposal to the Government in pursuance with the said announcement. She has requested that for meeting the skilled man power requirement of the proposal Special Economic Zone and Jayamkondam Lignite Power Project, an Industrial Training Institute at Andimadam in Perambalur District may be started with the following trades:-

1. Fitter - 2 Years
2. Electrician - 2 Years
3. Welder - 1 Year
4. Mechanic Motor Vehicle - 2 Years
5. Mechanic Mechatronics - 2 Years
6. COPA - 1 Year

The Special Commissioner and Commissioner of Employment and Training has sent the details of the trades to be started, cost of tools and equipments, establishment charges etc. and the staff required as per the National Council for Vocational Training norms. She has added that no surplus staff is available in Employment and Training Department for deployment and that staff are to be sanctioned by creation.

- 3. The Special Commissioner and Commissioner of Employment and Training has stated that for starting the Industrial Training Institute, 15 acres of land is required including for future expansion and that the land may be allotted from Government Poramboke land. She has not included the cost of building in the proposal and stated that buildings including hostel for 60 trainees are essential as per National Council for Vocational Training norms for starting the courses. (The carpet area required for administrative building, class room, workshop, hostel etc. comes to 1711.92 Sq.m.) She has suggested that the buildings may be constructed out of area development fund of MP/ MLAs and that before starting the construction work building plan may be prepared in consultation with the Employment and Training department. She has suggested that the Industrial Training Training may be started in August, 2007 and that till the construction work is completed, the Industrial Training Institute may function in a rented building. She has requested for sanctioning a sum of Rs.278.25 lakhs (recurring Rs.57.50 lakhs and Non-recurring Rs.220.75 lakhs), restricting the expenditure to Rs.248.24 lakhs (recurring Rs.27.49 lakhs and non-recurring Rs.220.75 lakhs) for the year 2007-2008 and that a new head of account may be opened and necessary funds be provided in BE 2007-2008, to start the course in August, 2007.
- 4. The Government have examined the proposal in detail and accord sanction for starting of the new Government Industrial Training Institute at Andimadam in Perambalur District with the trades, units, duration and the total number of seats indicated against each mentioned in Annexure I to this order. The Government also accord sanction for the staff by creation of new posts as mentioned in Annexure II and for the cost of Tools and Equipments and the furniture as per Annexure III to this order.
- 5. The Government also accord sanction for a sum of Rs.248.24 lakhs (Rupees Two hundred and forty eight lakhs and twenty four thousands only) (i.e recurring Rs.27.49 lakhs and non-recurring Rs.220.75 lakhs) for starting the Industrial Training Institute with 216 seats mentioned in Annexure IV to this order.
- 6. The expenditure sanctioned in para 5 above shall be debited to the following head of Account:
 - " 2230 Labour and Employment 03. Training 101 Industrial Training Institute Schemes in the Eleventh Five Year Plan I Non- Plan AA- Industrial Training Institutes."
