APPENDIX. NOTIFICATION.

The following draft of a Notification which it is proposed to issue in exercise of the powers conferred by clause (b) of sub-section (1) of section 3 and sub-section (2) of section 5 of the Minimum Wages Act, 1948 (Central Act XI of 1948) is hereby published for information of all persons likely to be affected thereby, as required by clause (b) of sub-section (1) of section 5 of the said Act.

2. Notice is hereby given that the draft Notification will be taken into consideration on or after the expiry of two months from the date of publication of this Notification in the <u>Tamil Nadu Government Gazette</u> and that any objection or suggestion, which may be received from any person with respect thereto before the expiry of the aforesaid period of two months will be considered by the Government of Tamil Nadu. Objection or suggestion, if any, should be addressed to the Secretary to Government, Labour and Employment Department, Secretariat, Chennai-600 009 through the Commissioner of Labour, Chennai-600 006.

DRAFT NOTIFICATION.

In exercise of the powers conferred by clause (b) of sub-section (1) of section 3 and sub-section (2) of section 5 of the Minimum Wages Act, 1948 (Central Act XI of 1948) and in supersession of the Labour and Employment Department Notification No.II(2)/LE/ 357/2004, published at pages 222 and 223 of Part II-Section 2 of the Tamil Nadu Government Gazette, dated the 19th May 2004, the Governor of Tamil Nadu hereby revises the minimum rates of wages payable to the classes of employees in the employment in loading and unloading operation in markets, shandies (fairs and market places) and other like places in the State of Tamil Nadu for the classes of work specified in column (2) of the Schedule below, as specified in the corresponding entries in column (3) thereof:-

- <u>2. Dearness Allowance :-</u> The employees referred to above, apart from the minimum wages, are eligible for getting dearness allowance as detailed below:-
 - (i) The dearness allowance shall be linked to the Average Consumer Price Index number of the city of Chennai at 475 points with base (1982=100) and for every rise of one point over and above 475 points, an increase of 17 paise (Seventeen paise only) per day shall be paid as dearness allowance.
 - (ii) The revision of dearness allowance shall be effective from the 1st April of every year on the basis of the average consumer price indices of the proceding 12 months, that is, from January to December.
 - (iii) The first calculation shall thus be effective from the date of publication of this Notification in the <u>Tamil Nadu Government</u> <u>Gazette</u> based on the Average Consumer Price Index for the previous year.
- 3. When the nature of the work is the same, no distinction in the payment of wages shall be made between men and women workers.
- 4. Wherever the existing wages are higher than the minimum wages fixed herein, the same higher wages shall be continued to be paid.
