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### **ORDER:**

The Hon'ble Minister for Labour while moving Demand for the year 2010-2011, on the floor of Assembly on 30.4.2010 has made an announcement that for the benefit of employees, Employees State Insurance Scheme will be extended to West Avinashi area by attaching to the existing Employees State Insurance Dispensary with the concurrence of Employees State Insurance Corporation.

2. In the letter read above, the Director of Medical and Rural Health Services (ESI), has sent the proposal for implementation of Employees State Insurance Scheme in West Avinashi area, Coimbatore District by attachment with the existing Employees State Insurance Dispensary, Avinashi, Coimbatore District.

3. The Government after careful examination, accept the proposal of the Director of Medical and Rural Health Services (ESI) and sanction the implementation of Employees State Insurance Scheme in West Avinashi area, Coimbatore District by attaching 1547 employees with the existing Employees State Insurance Dispensary at Avinashi, Coimbatore District.

4. Sanction is also accorded for incurring a recurring expenditure of Rs.6,96,150/- (Rupees Six lakhs ninety six thousand one hundred and fifty only) towards cost of medicine to 1547 employees and their family members.

5. The facilities like specialist treatment, hospitalization, laboratory test, X-ray etc., would be made available by way of referring the beneficiaries to the Employees State Insurance Hospital, Coimbatore.

6. The expenditure sanctioned in paragraph 4 above, shall be debited to the following head of account:-

"2210 Medical and Public Health-01 Urban Health Services Allopathy-102 Employees State Insurance Scheme.I Non-Plan AG-Expenditure on ESI Scheme- Both Insured persons and their families – 66 medicine."

(D.P.C.2210-01-102-AG-6605).

7. The expenditure sanctioned in paragraph 4 above constitute an item of "New Instrument of Service". The approval of the Legislature will be obtained in due course pending approval of the Legislature the expenditure will initially be met from an advance drawn from the contingency fund, order regarding which will be issued separately in Finance (BG1) Department. The Director of Medical and Rural Health Services (ESIS) is directed to apply for sanctioning contingency fund in the prescribed proforma along with the copy of this order to Government in Finance (BG1) Department. The Director of Medical and Rural Health Services (ESIS) is also directed to send necessary notes to Government in Finance Department for inclusion of the expenditure in the Supplementary Estimates to obtain the approval of the Legislature at the appropriate time.

8. The expenditure will be initially incurred by the State Government out of Budgetary provision/Additional funds now sanctioned in 2010-2011 and fully reimbursed from the Employees State Insurance Corporation for the first three year period, from the date of implementation of Employees State Insurance Scheme in the above area and thereafter, the expenditure shall be shared between the Employees State Insurance Corporation and the State Government in the agreed ratio of 7:1.

9. The formal Notification under Section 1(3) of the Employees State Insurance Act, 1948, fixing the date from which the medical facilities shall be extended to the Insured Persons and their families in the above area will be issued by the Central Government.

10. The Director of Medical and Rural Health Services(ESIS) shall suggest immediately a suitable date for the extension of the Employees State Insurance Scheme to the above area after making all the medical

arrangements in the said dispensary in consultation with the Regional Director, Employees State Insurance Corporation, Chennai.

11. This order issues with the concurrence of the Finance Department vide its U.O.No.175/JS(PM)/10, Dated 24.9.2010 and the Additional Sanction Ledger No.1008 (One thousand and eight).
