NOTIFICATION

Whereas the Industries Manufacturing Heavy Diesel Engines have been declared to be a public utility service for the purpose of the ID Act, 1947 (Central Act XIV 0f 1947)

Now, therefore, in exercise of powers conferred by sub-clause (vi) of clause (n) of section 2 of the said Act, the Governor of Tamil Nadu here by declares the Industries Manufacturing Heavy Duty Diesel Engines to be a Public Utility Service for the purpose of the said Act for a period of six months from the date of publication of this Notification in the Tamilnadu Government Gazette.
