APPENDINX. NOTIFICATION.

In exercise of the powers conferred by clause (b) of sub – section (l) of section 3 and sub – section (2) of section 5 of the Minimum Wages Act, 1948(Central Act XI of 1948) and in supersession of the Labour and Employment Department Notification No.II(2)/LE/648/2002 published at pages 423 and 424 of Part II- Section 2 of the Tamil Nadu Government Gazette, dated the 7th August 2002, the Governor of Tamil Nadu, after consultation with the advisory board, hereby revises the minimum rates of wages as specified in column (2) of the Schedule below as payable to the classes of employees in the employment in paper and other incidental processes connected with the machine made paper industry in the State of Tamil Nadu, specified in column (1) thereof.

2. This Notification shall come into force with effect on and from the date of its publication in the <u>TamilNadu Government Gazette</u>

<u>EXPLANATIONS.--</u> (1)<u>Dearness Allowance</u>.-- In addition to the above minimum rates of wages, the employees shall be paid dearness allowance as indicated below:-

- (I) Wages fixed herein are linked to the Average Chennai City Consumer Price Index for the year 2000, i.e., 475 points (with base 1982=100) and for any future rise of every point, over and above 475 points, an increase of Rs. 4.75 (Rupees Four and paise seventy five only) per month shall be paid as dearness allowance.
- (II) The dearness allowance shall be calculated every year on the 1st April, on the basis of the average of the Index for the preceding 12 months, i.e., from January to December.
- (III) The first calculation shall, thus, be effective from the date of publication of the Notification in the <u>Tamil Nadu Government Gazette</u>, based on the average index of the previous year.
- (2) Where the same work or work of a similar nature is performed by women, no distinction in payment of wages shall be made, as between men and women employees.

- (3) To arrive at daily wages, the monthly wages shall be divided by 26.
- (4) Wherever the existing wages are higher than the minimum wages fixed herein, the same shall be continued to be paid.
