ORDER:

In the Government Order first read above the minimum rates of wages for the employment in Gunny Industry were fixed under the provisions of the Minimum Wages Act, 1948 (Central Act XI of 1948). The Government have now proposed to further revise these minimum rates of wages for employment in Gunny Industry.

APPENDIX. NOTIFICATION.

The following draft of a Notification which it is proposed to issue in exercise of the powers conferred by clause (b) of sub-section (1) of section 3 and sub-section (2) of section 5 of the Minimum Wages Act, 1948 (Central Act XI of 1948) is hereby published for information of all persons likely to be affected thereby, as required by clause (b) of sub-section (1) of section 5 of the said Act.

2. Notice is hereby given that the draft Notification will be taken into consideration on or after the expiry of two months from the date of publication of this Notification in the <u>Tamil Nadu Government Gazette</u> and that any objection or suggestion, which may be received from any person with respect thereto before the expiry of the aforesaid period of two months will be considered by the Government of Tamil Nadu. Objection or suggestion, if any, should be addressed to the Principal Secretary to Government, Labour and Employment Department, Secretariat, Chennai-600 009 through the Commissioner of Labour, Chennai-600 006.

DRAFT NOTIFICATION.

In exercise of the powers conferred by clause (b) of sub-section (1) of section 3 and sub-section (2) of section 5 of the Minimum Wages Act, 1948 (Central Act XI of 1948) and in super session of the Labour and Employment Department Notification No.II(2)/LE/ 911/2005, published at pages 513 and 514 of Part II-Section 2 of the <u>Tamil Nadu Government Gazette</u>, dated the 14 December 2005, the Governor of Tamil Nadu hereby revises the minimum rates of wages payable to the classes of employees in the employment in gunny industry in the State of Tamil Nadu for the classes of employees specified in column (1) of the Schedule below as specified in the corresponding entries in column (2) thereof:-

THE SCHEDULE.

EMPLOYMENT IN GUNNY INDUSTRY.

Classes of Employees	Minimum Rates of Wages per day
(1)	(2)
(1) Gunny Bag Stitcher	130.00
(2) Maistry	138.00
(3) Piece rated wages	1.61 per Gunny Bag

<u>Explanations.- (1) Dearness Allowance.-</u> In addition to the minimum wages fixed above, the employees shall be paid Dearness Allowance as indicated below:-

- (i) The Dearness Allowance, is linked to the Average Consumer Price Index of Chennai City for the year 2000 that is, 475 points (with base 1982=100) and for every rise of every one point over and above 475 points, an increase of 27 paise (twenty seven paise) per day shall be paid as dearness allowance.
- (ii) The dearness allowance shall be calculated every year on the 1st April on the basis of the average of the indices for the preceding 12 months, that is, from January to December.
- (iii)The first calculation of the dearness allowance shall thus be effective from the date of publication of this Notification in the <u>Tamil Nadu Government Gazette</u> based on the average Chennai City Consumer Price Index for the previous year.
- (2) Where the nature of work is the same, no distinction in the payment of wages shall be made between male and female workers.
- (3) To arrive at daily rates of wages, the daily wages shall be multiplied by 30.
- (4) Wherever the existing wages are higher than the minimum wages fixed herein, such higher wages shall be continued to be paid.
