ORDER:

According to rule 49(c) of the General Rules for the Tamil Nadu State and Subordinate Services, introduced with effect from 24.1.1961, "any application for alteration of date of birth received after five years, after entry into service shall be summarily rejected unless the applicant gives adequate explanation for making such belated application to the authority competent to deal with it. Subsequently, amendments were issued to this sub-rule that "any application received after five years after entry into service, shall be summarily rejected." This amendment come into retrospective effect from 24.1.1961.

- 2. The above time-limit of 5 years will not debar the Government servants who entered into service prior to 24.1.1961, from making application for alteration of date of birth at any time before their retirement. In most cases, such Government servants tender their applications for alteration of the date of their birth at the fag end of their service thereby causing administrative difficulties in prescribed in the rules. The Government, after careful examination, have decided to prescribe a time limit for submitting such applications. They have, therefore, decided that the Government servants who entered into Government service prior to 24.1.61 and who wish to apply for alteration of the date of their birth should do so atleast one year before the date of their retirement.
- 3. The following Notification will be published in the Tamil Nadu Government Gazette:-

NOTIFICATION

In exercise of the powers conferred by the proviso to Article 309 of the Constitution of India, the Governor of Tamil Nadu hereby makes the following amendment to the

General Rules for the Tamil Nadu State and Subordinate Services (Part II in Volume I of the Tamil Nadu Services Manual, 1987).

2. The amendment hereby made shall come into force on the 15th December 1992.

AMENDMENT

In the said Rules, in rule 49, in sub-rule (c) the following proviso shall be added, namely:-

"Provided that the application for alteration of date of birth of a person who entered into service prior to the 24th January 1961 shall be submitted at least one year before the date of his retirement reckoned with reference to the official records."
