Sub : Government Servants – Availing of Consumer Loan from Private agencies through office – banned.

At the Secretaries Meeting held on 29.10.90 the question of allowing Government servants to avail the consumer loan schemes sponsored by private banks/Financial/Commercial institutions through their office was discussed. It has been brought to notice that consumer loan schemes extended by private and nationalized banks/financial/commercial institutions are being availed of by Government servants through their offices. It has been decided that Government need not involve themselves in financial transactions of a private nature like consumer loan etc.

- 2. All Secretaries to Government and Heads of Departments are therefore requested to ensure that the O.P. Establishment sections of their offices do not involve themselves in this kind of private financial transaction by giving undertaking etc., for recovery of monthly instalments to the private/nationalized banks/financial/commercial institutions for availing consumer loan by Government servants.
- 3. These instructions will not apply to Co-operative Banks, Co-optex and Tamil Nadu Khadi & Village Industries Board which are extending credit facilities to Government servants.

4. These instructions come into force with immediate effect.
