ORDER:

In the Government Order first read above orders were issued regulating the scheme of surrender of Earned Leave for 15 days every year / 30 days every two years while on duty and also while on any kind of leave (except Extra-ordinary Leave without allowances). In the Government Order second read above orders were issued suspending the facility of surrender of Earned Leave for encashment initially for a period of one year with effect from 28.11.2001. Subsequently, in the Government Order third read above, the suspension of facility of surrender of Earned Leave for encashment has been extended until further orders. In the Government Order fourth read above orders were issued restoring the facility of surrender of Earned Leave for encashment for 7 days in a year as per the regular annual cycle. Subsequently in the Government Order fifth read above, orders were issued restoring the facility of surrender of Earned Leave for surrender of Earned Leave for 15 days as per the regular annual cycle.

- 2. The Government have examined the restoration of facility of surrender of Earned leave for 30 days for every two years which was in vogue prior to .28.11.2001. After careful examination the Government have now decided to restore the same.
- 3 Accordingly, Government direct that the facility of surrender of Earned Leave for 30 days for every two years be restored with effect from the date of issue of order. Government Employees and Teachers are permitted to surrender 30 days of Earned Loave for every two years in lieu of cash at their credit as per the regular annual cycle. There shall be an interval of not less than two years period from the date of sanction of previous surrender of leave.
