ORDER:

In pursuant to the orders issued in the G.O.'s second and fourth read above, for revising the syllabus for the Jail Test, Part – I and Part – II and the Departmental Tests for officers of the Probation Branch of the Jail Department, the Secretary, Tamil Nadu Public Service Commission in his letter fifth read above has sent the draft amendment proposal for incorporation of the revised syllabus for the Jail Test, Part –I & Part -II relating to the Jail Department in the Annexure II of G.O. Ms. No. 21 Personnel and Administrative Reforms (M) Department dated 10-01-1990.

2. The following Notification shall be published in the Tamil Nadu Government Gazette:-

NOTIFICATION

The following amendments are issued to G.O. Ms. No. 21 Personnel and Administrative Reforms (M) Department dated the 10th January 1990, published in Personnel and Administrative Reforms (Per.M) Department Notification No. II (2) / Personnel and Administrative Reforms. 6601 (m-a) at pages 1-59 in Part II — Section 2 (Supplement) of the <u>Tamil Nadu Government Gazette</u>, dated the 18th December 1991:-

2. The amendments hereby made shall be deemed to have been come into force on and from 26th June 2003.
