ORDER:

The Government in the reference first read above, have issued orders that the upper age limit for entering into Government service shall be relaxed by five years, so as to enable the unemployed youth affected by the ban order on recruitment, to apply for Government jobs. In the reference second read above, Government have extended this concession to those who are already in Government Service, so as to enable them to write the competitive examination conducted by the Tamil Nadu Public Service Commission.

2. The Government have, therefore, decided to make a provision in the General Rules for Tamil Nadu State and Subordinate Services accordingly.

3. The following Notification will be published in the Tamil Nadu Government Gazette:-

NOTIFICATION

In exercise of the powers conferred by the proviso to Article 309 of the Constitution of India, the Governor of Tamil Nadu hereby makes the following amendment to the General Rules in Part II of the Tamil Nadu State and Subordinate Services Rules (Volume I of the Tamil Nadu Services Manual, 1987).

2. The amendment hereby made shall be deemed to have come into force on the 17th July 2006.

AMENDMENT.

In the said Rules, after rule 54-A, the following rule shall be inserted, namely:-

"54-B Age concession for persons affected due to the ban on direct recruitment. - Notwithstanding anything contained in the Special rules for the various State and Subordinate Services or in any adhoc rules applicable to any temporary post, in the case of a person who has been affected due to the ban on direct recruitment that was imposed on the 29th November 2001, the upper age limit shall be raised to a maximum period of five years reckoned on and from the 17th July 2006, ending with the 16th July 2011, in computing his age for appointment to any post under the State Government, except the categories of posts of Teachers, Doctors and Police Constabulary and shall be applicable in respect of notifications issued or selections made by competent recruiting authorities or appointments made by competent appointing authorities during the aforesaid period".


