ORDER:

The Second Administrative Reforms Commission (ARC) was constituted by the Government of India on 31.08.2005, as a Commission of Inquiry, under the Chairmanship of **Shri Veerappa Molly** to suggest measures to achieve a proactive, responsive, accountable, sustainable and efficient administration for the country at all levels of the Government. The Commission submitted 15 Reports to the Government of India for consideration. As the recommendations contained in these reports pertain to Central Government as well as State Governments, the Government of India have forwarded the above reports and requested to take follow up action on the recommendations. The reports received from the Government of India have been forwarded to the Department concerned for follow up action.

2. In this connection, the status of implementation of recommendations of the above reports was discussed in a meeting with a Senior Officer deputed by the Government of India with Chief Secretary on 22.7.2011. During the discussion it was decided that a Committee headed by the Chief Secretary may be constituted to monitor follow up action on the reports of the Second Administrative Reforms Commission and the Principal Secretary, Personnel and Administrative Reforms Department may be the Member Secretary to the Committee and the concerned Secretaries as Members.

3. Accordingly, the Government constitute a Committee under the Chairmanship of the Chief Secretary to Government and the Principal Secretary, Personnel and Administrative Reforms Department as the Member Secretary and the following Secretaries as Members, to review the follow up action on the Reports of Second Administrative Reforms Commission of Government of India as detailed below:-


