### **ORDER :-**

In the Government Order read above, among other things, orders were issued amending the Special Rules for the Tamil Nadu General Subordinate Service in Class XLIII Department of Economics and Statistics in rule 4, the educational qualifications prescribed for the post of Assistant Statistical Investigator through direct recruitment and recruitment by transfer are as follows:-

### **Assistant Statistical Investigator [Direct Recruitment] :-**

a) Degree in Statistics;

OR

Degree in Mathematics/Computer Science/Economics/Computer Applications with Statistics as an ancillary/allied subject;

OR

Any degree with Post graduate degree in Operations Research/  
Econometrics/Mathematical Economics.

Provided the candidates with the above degrees other than Statistics are expected to be fully conversant with basic level concepts of Statistics including Bayes' theorem in Probability, Probability distributions like Binomial, Poisson, Normal, t, Chi-Square & F, Probability Generating Functions, Moment Generating Function, Theory of Estimation, Testing of Hypothesis using various Statistical Tests like Z, t, F, Chi-Square, basics of Multiple Regression and Multivariate analysis and Sampling design. In addition, they should have basic skills in using MS-Excel for statistical data analysis.

b) Must not complete or must not have completed 30 years of age on the 1<sup>st</sup> day of July of the year in which the selection for appointment is made.

**Assistant Statistical Investigator [Recruitment by Transfer] :-**

- a) Degree in Statistics;  
OR  
Degree in Mathematics/Computer Science/Economics/Computer Applications with Statistics as an ancillary/ allied subject;  
OR  
Any degree with Post graduate degree in Operations Research/ Econometrics/Mathematical Economics.
- b) Must have put in a service of not less than three years in the category of Junior Assistant or Typist as the case may be.
- c) Must have passed the Departmental Test on Statistics.

2. Accordingly, the Government have decided that the candidates appearing for the recruitment for the post of Assistant Statistical Investigator shall be tested for their proficiency by Tamil Nadu Public Service Commission in the areas specified in the proviso to the educational qualification. For this purpose, Tamil Nadu Public Service Commission will need to conduct examinations for the post of Assistant Statistical Investigator by setting two papers only, namely, one paper on General Studies/General Knowledge and the other paper on the subject 'Statistics' covering the areas specified in the proviso. Through these means, the Tamil Nadu Public Service Commission will be able to verify the proficiency of all candidates on an equitable basis to meet the requirements of the Department of Economics and Statistics. Further, the feeder categories for the post of Assistant Statistical Investigator i.e., Junior Assistant and Typist shall pass the Departmental test conducted by the Tamil Nadu Public Service Commission in Statistics in the areas specified in the proviso to the educational qualification applicable to the post of Assistant Statistical Investigator (Direct Recruitment) as revised in the Government Order read above.

3. Government, after detailed examination, prescribes the following yardstick for assessing the candidates for the post of Assistant Statistical Investigator through direct recruitment and recruitment by transfer :-

- (i). that the candidates appearing for the recruitment shall be tested by the Tamil Nadu Public Service Commission in the areas specified in the proviso to the educational qualification applicable to the post of Assistant Statistical Investigator (Direct Recruitment) as revised in the Government Order read above.
- (ii). the written examination for the post of Assistant Statistical Investigator (Direct Recruitment), Tamil Nadu Public Service Commission shall set two papers (viz.) General Studies/General Knowledge and Statistics.
- (iii). The subject paper on Statistics will cover the areas indicated in the proviso to the educational qualification applicable to the post of Assistant Statistical Investigator (Direct Recruitment) as revised in the Government Order read above.

- (iv). The Tamil Nadu Public Service Commission shall conduct a Departmental Test in Statistics paper at a level considered by the Tamil Nadu Public Service Commission as equal to the Statistics paper set for the Assistant Statistical Investigator (Direct Recruitment) and the Junior Assistants/Typists shall pass this Departmental Test on Statistics for their further promotion as Assistant Statistical Investigator through Recruitment by Transfer method.
