

Horticulture – Integrated Horticulture Development Scheme – Implementation in Non-National Horticulture Mission (Non-NHM) Districts during 2015-16 at an outlay of Rs.334.89 lakh – Orders – Issued.

 From the Director of Horticulture and Plantation Crops, Letter No.SS2/7426/2015, dated 14.05.2015 and 13.7.2015.

ORDER:-

In Government Order first read above, Government accorded sanction for implementation of Integrated Horticulture Development Scheme (IHDS) during 2014-15, in 9 Non-National Horticulture Mission (Non-NHM) Districts viz. Kancheepuram, Thiruvallur, Karur, Namakkal, Thiruvarur, Tuticorin, Nagapattinam, Thiruvannamalai and Virudhunagar Districts of Tamil Nadu at an outlay of Rs.5.00 crore.

- 2. The Director of Horticulture and Plantation Crops in his letter second read above has sent a proposal for continuance of Integrated Horticulture Development Scheme (IHDS) in 9 Non-National Horticulture Mission (Non-NHM) Districts with Mission for Integrated Development of Horticulture (MIDH) guidelines during 2015-16, at an outlay of Rs.334.89 lakh. He has stated that under this scheme, focus will be given to area expansion of Vegetables, Fruits, Spices, Flowers and Plantation crops. In respect of Vegetables and Flower crops, hybrid seed material and planting material will be distributed to farmers at 40% subsidy in total cost of cultivation upto 2 ha. In respect of Fruits, Spices and Plantation Crops, planting material and Seed & Seedlings of Spices will be distributed to farmers at 40% subsidy in total cost of cultivation upto 4 ha. He has also stated that, 20.01% of the total allocation under area expansion is proposed to be utilized for Scheduled Caste farmers and 1.10% is proposed to be utilized for Scheduled Tribes farmers.
- 3. The Government after careful consideration of the proposal of Director of Horticulture and Plantation Crops, accord sanction for implementation of Integrated Horticulture Development Scheme (IHDS) in 9 Non-National Horticulture Mission (Non-NHM) Districts viz. Kancheepuram, Thiruvallur, Karur, Namakkal, Thiruvarur, Tuticorin, Nagapattinam, Thiruvannamalai and Virudhunagar during 2015-16 at an outlay of Rs.334.89 lakh (Rupees Three Crore thirty four lakhs and eighty nine thousand only) by the following Mission for Integrated Development of Horticulture (MIDH) guidelines. The funds shall be allocated as follows:-

General Category

= Rs. 264.195 Lakh

Schedule Caste Category

= Rs. 67.011 Lakh

Schedule Tribes Category

= Rs. 3.684 Lakh

Total

= Rs. 334.890 Lakh

- 4. The Head of Account under which the expenditure for the above scheme shall be debited and receipt credited are shown in the Annexure to this order.
- 5. Necessary additional funds will be provided in Revised Estimate/Final Modified Appropriation 2015-16 to rneet the expenditure sanctioned in para 3 above. Pending provision of such funds in Revised Estimate/Final Modified Appropriation 2015-16, the Director of Horticulture and Plantation Crops is authorized to draw and disburse the amount. However this expenditure shall be brought to the notice of Legislative by specific inclusion in the Supplementary Estimates 2015-16. The Director of Horticulture and Plantation Crops is directed to include the expenditure sanctioned above, while sending the Budget proposal of Revised Estimate/Final Modified Appropriation 2015-16 and also to send necessary Explanatory note for including the above expenditure in the supplementary Estimates 2015-16 to Finance (BG-I) Department.
 - 6. The crops will be distributed as following:

(i) Vegetable Crops:

Hybrid vegetable seeds will be distributed at 40% subsidy in total cost of cultivation/Hybrid seed materials gives higher yield tomato, brinjal, bhendi, beans, carrot, beetroot, cabbage, cauliflower etc will be distributed. A Beneficiary can avail benefit upto 2 ha.

(ii) Fruit Crops:

The pedigree planting materials of mango, sapota, aonla, guava etc, will be distributed at 40% subsidy in total cost of cultivation. A beneficiary can avail benefit upto 4 ha.

(iii) Spices crops:

Seed and seedlings of spices will be distributed at 40% subsidy in total cost of cultivation to enhance area under spice crops in the potential districts. A beneficiary can avail benefit upto 4 ha.

(iv) Flower Crops:

The planting materials of flower crops will be distributed to farmers at 40% subsidy in total cost of cultivation. A beneficiary can avail benefit upto 2 ha.

(v) Plantation Crops:

The planting material of plantation crop are distributed at 40% subsidy in total cost of cultivation. A beneficiary can avail benefit upto 4 ha.
