ORDER:

In the Government Order first read above, the minimum rates of wages for the employment in any Oil Mill were revised under the provisions of the Minimum Wages Act, 1948 (Central Act XI of 1948).

- 2. In the Government Order second read above, a Preliminary Notification was published in order to further revise the minimum rates of wages for the above said employment.
- 3. The Principal Secretary / Commissioner of Labour in his letter third read above, has stated that no objections and suggestions received from the persons likely to be affected by such revision were placed before the Minimum Wages (State) Advisory Board and was decided to conform the said Preliminary Notification without any modification. Hence has requested the Government to confirm the above said Preliminary Notification.
- 4. The Government have now decided to confirm the orders issued in the said Preliminary Notification, without any modification.

5. The appended Notification will accordingly be published in the <u>Tamil Nadu Government Gazette</u> both in English and Tamil. The Works Manager, Government Central Press, Chennai-600 001 is requested to publish the Notification and send each five copies of the Gazette to the Government and to the Commissioner of Labour, Chennai-600 006 for reference and record. The Director, Tamil Development and Information (Translation) Department, Secretariat, Chennai-600 009 is requested to send the Tamil translation of the Notification to the Works Manager, Government Central Press, Chennai-600 001.

APPENDIX. NOTIFICATION.

In exercise of the powers conferred by clause (b) of sub-section (1) of section 3 and sub-section (2) of section 5 of the Minimum Wages Act, 1948 (Central Act XI of 1948) and in supersession of the Labour and Employment Department Notification No. II(2)/LE/564/2019, published at pages 666 - 667 of Part II - Section 2 of the <u>Tamil Nadu Government Gazette</u>, dated the 10th July 2019, the Governor of Tamil Nadu, after consultation with the Advisory Board, hereby revises the minimum rates of wages payable to the classes of employees in the employment in any Oil Mill in the State of Tamil Nadu specified in column (1) of the Schedule below, as specified in the corresponding entries in column (2) thereof, the draft of the same having been previously published as required by clause (b) of sub-section (1) of section 5 of the said Act.

2. This Notification shall come into force with effect on and from the date of its publication in the <u>Tamil Nadu Government Gazette</u>.

Provided that in case of Rotary man, if the wages are paid on piece rate basis, they shall be paid at Rs.75.20 per bag of 80 kilograms of groundnut seeds and at Rs.92.25 per bag of 75 kilograms of gingelly seeds.

(8) Pint Man. 286.00 per day.

Provided that in case of Pint man, if the wages are paid on piece rate basis, they shall be paid at Rs.98.45 per bag of 80 kilograms of groundnut seeds and at Rs.115.50 per bag of 75 kilograms of gingelly seeds.

<u>Explanation</u>.- (1) Dearness Allowance.- In addition to the minimum rates of basic wages fixed above, the employees shall be paid dearness allowance as indicated below:-

- (i) The dearness allowance is linked to the Average Chennai City Consumer Price Index for the year 2010, that is 161 points (with base 2001=100) and for every raise of one point over and above 161 points, an increase of Rs.44.40 (Rupees Forty four and paise forty only) per month shall be paid as dearness allowance.
- (ii) The dearness allowance shall be calculated every year on the first April on the basis of the average of the indices for the preceding twelve months, that is from January to December.
- (iii) The first calculation shall thus be effective from the date of publication of this Notification in the <u>Tamil Nadu Government Gazette</u>, based on the Average Chennai City Consumer Price Index of the previous year.

- (2) Where the nature of work is the same, no distinction in the payment of wages shall be made between men and women employees.
- (3) (i) To arrive at daily rates of wages, the monthly wages shall be divided by 26.
 - (ii) To arrive at monthly rates of wages, the daily wages shall be multiplied by 30.
- (4) Wherever the existing wages are higher than the minimum wages fixed herein, the same shall be continued to be paid.
