In exercise of the powers conferred by the proviso to Article 309 of the Constitution of India, the Governor of Madras hereby makes the following rules.

The rules hereby made shall be deemed to have come into force on the 29th May 1965.

RULES

The General and Special Rules applicable to the holders of the permanent posts of Telephone Operators in category 15 of the Madras Ministerial Service, shall apply to the holders of the of the temporary post of Telephone Operator in the Office of the Director of Employment and Training, Madras sanctioned in G.O.Ms.No.2795 (Labour, Industries and Cooperation dated the 29th May 1965, subject to the modification specified in the following rules):-

<u>2.CONSTITUTION</u>: The post shall constitute a temporary addition the said category of the said service.

3. <u>APPOINTING AUTHORITY</u>: The appointing authority for the post shall be the Joint Director of Employment, Madras.

4. <u>QUALIFICATION</u>: No personnel shall be eligible for appointment to the post unless he has passed the Telephone Operator's course conducted by a recognized Institution.

Explanation: A recognized institution shall mean an institution/center under the posts and Telegraphs Department giving training in Telephone Operator's course or any other Institution, recognized by the Government of India or any State Government imparting training in the Telephone Operator's Course which is considered as suitable for employment as Telephone Operator in any Government department.

5.PAY: There shall be paid to the holder of the post monthly pay calculated in the scale of Rs.190-4-100-3-140.
