

**SEARCH COMMITTEE FOR APPOINTMENT OF STATE CHIEF INFORMATION
COMMISSIONER OF TAMIL NADU STATE INFORMATION COMMISSION**

Applications are invited from eligible persons for appointment to the post of State Chief Information Commissioner of the Tamil Nadu State Information Commission. In terms of Section 15(5) of the Right to Information Act, 2005, the State Chief Information Commissioner shall be a person of eminence in public life with wide knowledge and experience in law, science and technology, social service, management, journalism, mass-media or administration and governance.

In terms of Section 15(6) of the Act, State Chief Information Commissioner shall not be a Member of Parliament or Member of the Legislature of any State or Union Territory, as the case may be, or hold any other office of profit or connected with any political party or carrying on any business or pursuing any profession.

As per Section 16(1) of the Act, State Chief Information Commissioner shall hold office for a term of five years from the date on which he/she enters upon his/her office and shall not be eligible for reappointment. Provided that no State Chief Information Commissioner shall hold office as such after he/she has attained the age of 65 years.

The salary, allowances and other terms and conditions of service of the State Chief Information Commissioner shall be as may be specified by the Government of Tamil Nadu in accordance with law.
