ORDER :

As per the Policy / Prospectus issued every year for the admission to Post Graduate Medical Degree / Diploma / 6 years M.Ch. (Neuro Surgery) and MDS courses, the merit list is being drawn for a Total Mark of 100 by computing the Entrance Examination Marks and the marks for experience (90 marks for entrance examination + 10 marks for experience) and one mark for each completed year after the completion of Compulsory Rotatory Residential Internship (CRR) is being awarded for experience for both service and non service candidates to a maximum of ten marks and the service candidates are being awarded, one mark per year of service in rural areas and two marks per year of service in hilly, remote and difficult areas. Altogether the total marks awarded for experience will be restricted to 10 marks.

2. In the Government order 1st read above, orders have been issued for awarding of 2 marks for each year of Government service in Hilly regions to a maximum of 5 years, restricting to a total of 10 marks. In Government order 2nd read above, orders have been issued for awarding of 2 marks for each year of Government service to the Doctors who works in the Government Hospitals,
