ORDER :-

The Government of India release every year the Special Central Assistance towards creation of **'Capital Assets'** and for undertaking activities under **'General'** category for economic development of Scheduled Tribes in conjunction with the State's efforts in the Tribal Sub Plan.

2. In the letter first read above, the Under Secretary to Government of India , Ministry of Tribal Affairs, Government of India has conveyed the release of a sum of Rs.63,66,000/- (Rupees Sixty three lakh and sixty six Thousand only) towards creation of Capital Assets and Rs.1,53,67,000/- (Rupees One Crore fifty three lakh and sixty seven only) towards General activities totally Rs.2,17,33,000/- (Rs.1,53,67,000+ Rs.63,66,000) which is the First Installment of Grants-in-Aid to this Government under Special Central Assistance to Tribal Sub-Plan as payment of Central Assistance during the year 2014 -2015 for carrying out the activities proposed.

3. Accordingly, the Director, Tribal Welfare was requested to send the proposal for the amount Rs.217.33 lakh vide the letter second read above. In the letter third read above the Director, Tribal Welfare, had submitted the project proposal for the Grants – in-aid under the Scheme of Special Central Assistance to Tribal Sub-Plan to the amount of Rs.217.23 lakh for the year 2014-15.

4. The Government after careful examination, accord sanction for Rs.2,17,23,000/-(Rupees Two Crore Seventeen Lakh and Twenty Three Thousand only) as the first instalment under the Grant-in-Aid of Special Central Assistance to Tribal Sub-Plan for the year 2014-15 for the implementation of schemes mentioned in the Annexure to this Government order.

5. The expenditure sanctioned in para 4 above shall be debited to the following Head of Account :-

"2225 – Welfare of Scheduled Castes, Scheduled Tribes and other Backward Classes 02 – Welfare of Scheduled Tribes 794 – Special Central Assistance for Tribal Sub - Plan - Schemes in the Twelfth Five Year Plan - III - Centrally Sponsored - SA – Welfare Schemes for Scheduled Tribes in Integrated Rural Development Project Blocks under Tribal Sub Plan - 09 Grants-in-Aid – 09 others “
(DPC 2225 02 794 SA 0997).

6. The Director of Tribal Welfare is authorized to draw and disburse the amount sanctioned in para 4 above to the District Collectors / implementing Agencies concerned for the implementation of the schemes mentioned in the Annexure to this order.

7. The Director of Tribal Welfare is directed to release the amount to the implementing agencies for the activities already proposed by the State Government strictly in accordance with the guidelines of Government of India issued on 02-05-2003 under reference No.14020/5/2003-SG&C for the amount mentioned in para 4 above. The Director of Tribal Welfare should ensure the release of funds to the implementing authorities in time and it is utilized only for the activities approved by the Government of India.

8. The implementing authorities have to ensure that grants-in-aid is used for the purpose for which it is sanctioned after following due procedure in a transparent manner and after obtaining all necessary clearances as required under the various Central / State Acts, Rules, regulations, etc. In case of construction of infrastructure facilities, norms and Schedule of Rates (SOR) fixed by the State Government should be followed. The Director of Tribal Welfare is requested to ensure the expenditure incurred for this scheme does not exceed the amount sanctioned in para 4 above.

9. The implementing authorities for the person/family oriented schemes are directed to advertise about the scheme in local newspapers such as the grant allocated to the scheme and the numbers of persons/families to be benefited by availing the grant and requested to send a copy of such advertisement to Government /Director of Tribal Welfare for information.

10. The Director of Tribal Welfare is directed to maintain separate accounts for the Special Central Assistance funds operated and disbursed by him for the various components and also to maintain relevant registers for the various disbursement of assistance with full details of beneficiaries. The Director of Tribal Welfare should ensure

that the funds are utilized for the real purpose for which it has been sanctioned by the Government of India and that it reaches the actual Tribal beneficiaries in full without any shortfall or complaints. If any failure is noticed, severe action shall be taken against the officers concerned.

11. The District Collectors / Implementing Agencies are requested to send the progress report every quarter with physical and financial progress in the prescribed format to Government in Adi Dravidar and Tribal Welfare (MEC) Department. The Utilization Certificates may be furnished within 12 months from the date of release of the amount to Government through the Director of Tribal Welfare who shall be the overall monitoring authority for the scheme.

12. This Order issues with the concurrence of Finance Department vide its U.O.No.66274/AD&TW /2014, Dated 03.12. 2014 .
