



## **ABSTRACT**

Technical Education – Board of Examinations – Diploma courses in Polytechnic College – Two special grace chances for the old diploma level students to appear for the board examinations – Permission to conduct the special grace examinations in the month of October 2019 and April 2020 – Orders – Issued.

### **ORDER:**

In the Government Order first read above, orders have been issued granting permission to conduct the two special grace chance examinations for the old diploma level students of OR, NR, RR, RS, C, D, G, J and K schemes during the months of APRIL 2018 and OCTOBER 2018 under the current scheme of study and to collect an enhanced fee of Rs.500/- per subject from the students.

2. In the letters second read above, the Director of Technical Education has stated that the Board of Examinations conducts examinations to Diploma students under various schemes such as OR, NR, RR, RS, C, D, G, J and K and some students are yet to be fully qualified for award of Diploma due to arrears in some subjects. Every Diploma student is given three years time (6 chances) on supplementary basis to complete the arrear subjects after completion of course. After completing six supplementary chances, two more additional chances are given in the next academic year. Certain students who exhausted additional three year and additional one year chances are requesting for one more grace chance. He has further stated that many such students are writing to the Government and Directorate of Technical Education to give grace chances to clear their arrear subjects.

3. Considering the future and welfare of these supplementary students, the Director of Technical Education has requested the Government to grant permission to conduct two special grace chance examinations for the old diploma level students during October 2019 and April 2020 along with the regular diploma exams, under the current scheme of study and to collect an enhanced fee of Rs.750/- (Rupees Seven hundred and fifty only) per subject from the student as all other exam fee are enhanced by 50% as per G.O.(2D) No.25, Higher Education (B1) Department, dated 19.07.2018. Earlier Rs.500/- (Rupees Five hundred only) per subject was collected for Grace Chance Students. These students shall be asked to appear for the equivalent subject in the current scheme of study.
