ORDER:

The Director of Medical Education in his letter fourth read above has stated that the Rajah Muthiah Medical College attached to Annamalai University was handed over to Health and Family Welfare Department for treating it as Government Medical College and Hospital, Rani Meyyammai College of Nursing and Rajah Muthiah Dental College and Hospital at Cuddalore District vide Government Order third read above.

2. The Director of Medical Education has also stated that sanction has been accorded to service candidates undergoing M.Sc. (Nursing) course at Madras Medical College, Chennai and Madurai Medical College, Madurai to avail salary with all Dearness Allowance, House Rent Allowance, City Compensatory Allowance and Other Allowances subject to the condition that they should not use any government accommodation for availing House Rent Allowance vide Government Orders first and second read above respectively. Further, he has stated that the Raja Muthiah Medical College, Chidambaram is coming under the status of unaided medical institution and there is no power delegation to prepare salary bills to the service / non service candidates. In the previous years, the Government have sanctioned supernumerary posts for the in-service candidates studying in Rajah Muthiah Medical College, Chidambaram at Madras Medical College, Chennai.

3. The Director of Medical Education has, therefore, requested to sanction 26 posts for service candidates studying in M.Sc. (Nursing) course in Government College of Nursing, Cuddalore District as supernumerary posts in the College of Nursing, Madras Medical College, Chennai till the completion of their study and to sanction a full pay to the service candidates undergoing M.Sc. (Nursing) at Government College of Nursing, Cuddalore District. He has also requested to authorize the Dean, Madras Medical College, Chennai to draw and disburse the salary to the above twenty six nursing students studying Post Graduate Course at Government College of Nursing, Cuddalore District.

4. The Director of Medical Education has also furnished the details of the pay and allowances for 26 service candidates are detailed as below:-

5. The Government have examined the proposal of the Director of Medical Education and decided to accept the same and issue the following orders: -

- (i) 8 Supernumerary posts in the cadre of Nursing Tutor II Grade with the scale of pay Rs.36700-116200 (Level 17) and 18 Supernumerary posts in the cadre of Nurses with the scale of pay Rs.36000-114000 (Level 14) be created in the College of Nursing, Madras Medical College, Chennai for the purpose of claiming salary for the service candidates undergoing the Post Graduate course at Government Nursing College, Chidambaram, Cuddalore District for two years, subject to the condition that these supernumerary posts shall automatically be abolished as and when the candidates complete their course.
- (ii) The salary of 26 in-service candidates who are undergoing M.Sc. Nursing Course at Government College of Nursing, Chidambaram, Cuddalore District at an approximate cost of Rs.4,35,67,992/- (Rupees Four Crores Thirty Five Lakhs Sixty Seven Thousand Nine Hundred and Ninety Two only) be sanctioned for 24 months from the date of their joining in the course;

6. The expenditure sanctioned in para 5 above shall be debited to the following Head of Account: -

"2210 Medical and Public Health – 05 – Medical Education Training and Research – 105 Allopathy – State's Expenditure – AL – Improvements of Medical Colleges"

7. The Dean, Madras Medical College, Chennai is authorized to draw and disburse the amount mentioned in para 5 above.
