ORDER :

In the Government orders read above, orders were issued for availing Tie-up facilities with certain Primary Health Centres / Urban Health Training Centres to the Deans of 13 Government Medical Colleges for their MBBS students to undergo training, subject to the conditions that, students must be deputed in small batches and the training must not be detrimental to the normal functions of the Primary Health Centres.

2. The Director of Medical Education in her letter 6th read above has requested the Government to issue necessary modification orders to transfer the administrative control of the Government Primary Health Centres concerned including Building, Staff and Equipments to the Director of Medical Education from the Director of Public Health and Preventive Medicine so as to enable the Deans of respective Government Medical Colleges to supervise and monitor the said Government Primary Health Centres and to fulfill the minimum requirements of MCI norms.

3. The Government carefully examined the proposal of the Director of Medical Education and consider that the transfer of total control of the Primary Health Centres to the Deans of the respective Colleges will interfere with the

multifarious field activities and the National Health Programs being administered by the Primary Health Centres. However, with regard to the norms prescribed by the Medical Council of India, the Government direct that the technical control of the following Primary Health Centres and Urban Health Centres be vested with the Deans of the Government Medical Colleges noted against them so as to enable the Deans of respective Government Medical Colleges to supervise and monitor the said Government Primary Health Centres for their MBBS students to undergo training and to fulfill the minimum requirements of MCI norms :-


