ORDER:-

The Government of India in its letter first read above have informed that among others, the 7th Screening Committee has recommended for setting up of Burn Injuries Unit at Madurai Medical College / Government Rajaji Hospital, Madurai under the Scheme of National Programme for Prevention and Management of Burn Injuries (NPPMBI).

2. The Government of India in the letter second read above, among others, have forwarded Memorandum of Understanding for setting up of Burns Unit at Madurai Medical College / Government Rajaji Hospital, Madurai under the Scheme of National Programme for Prevention and Management of Burns Injuries (NPPMBI). In the Memorandum of Understanding, it is stated that the proposed funding norms

shared between Central Government and State Government in the ratio of 60:40 is as detailed below: -

3. The Government of Tamil Nadu in the letter third read above, have forwarded the Memorandum of Understanding in original duly signed by the State Government to the Ministry of Health and Family Welfare, Government of India to take necessary action to release of funds to Madurai Medical College / Government Rajaji Hospital at Madurai under scheme of the National Programme for Prevention and Management of Burn Injuries (NPPMBI).

4. The Government of India in the letter fourth read above has conveyed the sanction of the President to the payment of a sum of Rs.2,07,90,000/- (Rupees Two crore seven lakh and ninety thousand only) being the release of first installment (60%) towards construction and procurement of equipment to Madurai Medical College / Government Rajaji Hospital at Madurai under the National Programme for Prevention and Management of Burn Injuries, as per the details given below:-

In the meantime, the Hon'ble Minister (Health and Family Welfare) has also announced on the floor of Assembly during the Budget Speech on 04.07.2017 that Burns Unit will be established at four Medical Colleges at Vellore, Salem, Coimbatore and Madurai at a cost of Rs.6.57 crore each, totaling Rs.26.28 crore.

6. In the letter fifth read above, the Director of Medical Education has sent the proposal and requested the Government to issue of necessary administrative and financial sanction for the construction of civil works and procurement of equipment for setting up of Burns Unit to Madurai Medical College / Government Rajaji Hospital at Madurai under the Scheme of National Programme for Prevention and Management of Burn Injuries (NPPMBI).

7. The Government, after careful examination of the proposal of the Director of Medical Education, accord administrative and financial sanction for a sum of Rs.3,46,50,000/- (Rupees Three crore forty six lakh and fifty thousand only) (Central Share - Rs.2,07,90,000/- and State Share - Rs.1,38,60,000/) towards construction of building at a cost of Rs.2,17,50,000/- (Rupees Two crore seventeen lakh and fifty thousand only) and purchase of equipment at a total cost Rs.1,29,00,000/- (Rupees one crore and twenty nine lakh only) for establishing a Burns Unit at Madurai Medical College / Government Rajaji Hospital, Madurai under National Programme for Prevention and Management of Burn Injuries (NPPMBI) with the sharing pattern between Government of India and State Government of Tamil Nadu as 60 : 40, respectively.

8. The expenditure sanctioned in para 7 above shall be debited to the following Heads of accounts (Demand 19 03):-

i) Purchase of Equipments:-

“2210. Medical and Public Health – 01. Urban Health Services - Allopathy – 110. Hospitals and Dispensaries – Schemes shared between State and Centre – UD. National Programme for Prevention and Management of Burn Injuries (NPPMBI) – 19. Machinery and Equipment – 01. Purchase”

ii) Construction of Buildings:-

“4210 – Capital Outlay on Medical and Public Health – 01 - Urban Health Services – 200 – Other Health Schemes – Schemes shared between State and Centre – UB National Programme for Prevention and Management of Burn Injuries (NPPMBI) – 16 Major works.

9. The Director of Medical Education is directed that the amount sanctioned in para 7 above for equipment (Rs.1,29,00,000/-) shall not be paid in cash, but credited to the following Personal Deposit Account of Tamil Nadu Medical Services Corporation Limited:-

“K. Deposits and Advances - (b). Deposits not bearing interest – 8443.00.
– Civil Deposits – 800. Other Deposits – CE. Deposits of Tamil Nadu Medical Services Corporation Limited (TNMSC).
(DPC 8443 – 00 – 800 – CE – 00 OH (Receipts))”.

10. The Director of Medical Education is authorized to draw and disburse the amount sanctioned in para 7 above for construction of building (Rs.2,17,50,000/-) to the Chief Engineer (Building), Chennai.
