ORDER:

In Government Order first read above, among others, orders have been issued for the prescription of fees for the following procedures conducted at the department of Radio diagnosis, Government Kilpauk Medical College Hospital.

- i. Screening Mammogram : Rs. 1,000/-
- ii. Contrast Mammogram : Rs. 1,200/-
- iii. Core Needle Stereo Biopsy : Rs. 3,050/-
- iv. Stereo Guided VAB extraction
of Micro calcification : Rs.29,500/-

2. The Project Director, Tamil Nadu Health Systems Project has stated that in the Government Order first cited, it has been mentioned that except Screening Mammogram the other 3 components have not been covered under Chief Minister's Comprehensive Health Insurance Scheme. The Dean, Kilpauk Medical College has also requested to include the above 3 Mammogram related procedures under Chief Minister's Comprehensive Health Insurance Scheme as requested by the Professor and Head of the Department, Department of Radio diagnosis and the United India Insurance Company have furnished their remarks as follows:

1.	Screening Mammogram	:	Already included in the Diagnostic procedures at Rs. 950/-
2.	Contrast Mammogram	:	To be accommodated under the same package. Since only 15% cases need contrast, to consider including additional package as add on package of Rs. 1200/-
3.	Core Needle Stereo Biopsy	:	Already included under CMCHIS as Stereotactic Mammographic Biopsy.
4.	Stereo Guided VAB extraction of Micro Calcification	:	This procedure is not covered

3. The Project Director, Tamil Nadu Health Systems Project has agreed the remarks of the United India Insurance Company and proposed that the procedure, Stereo Guided

VAB extraction of Micro Calcification may be conducted for Chief Minister's Comprehensive Health Insurance Scheme beneficiaries and the fees as prescribed in the Government Order may be paid from Corpus fund and furnished the reasons for incurring the expenditure Corpus Fund as below:

- i. The procedure is not included in the present tender (2017 to 2022)
- ii. It is not possible to include in the tender till 2022.
- iii. Any how there is need to treat the Chief Minister's Comprehensive Health Insurance Scheme beneficiaries also for the above procedure particularly after the installation of the High end equipment (Prone Table Digital Mammogram System to perform 3D Tomosynthesis and Contrast Mammography) at Government Hospital (KMC) Chennai.

4. The Project Director, Tamil Nadu Health Systems Project has requested to issue orders for payment of fees of Rs. 29,500/- for each procedure/case (as prescribed by the Government) from Corpus Fund for conducting the test (Stereo Guided VAB extraction of Micro calcification) for Chief Minister's Comprehensive Health Insurance Scheme beneficiaries.

5. The Government have examined the proposal of the Project Director, Tamil Nadu Health Systems Project decided to accept and accordingly sanction a sum of Rs. 29,500/- from Corpus fund for each procedures/case (as prescribed by the Government) for conducting the test (Stereo Guided VAB extraction of Micro calcification) for Chief Minister's Comprehensive Health Insurance Scheme beneficiaries.

6. This order issues with the concurrence of the Finance Department vide its U.O.No. 29927/Health-II/2019, dated: 16.07.2019.

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
