#### ORDER:

In the Government Order first read above, the Government accorded sanction for the establishment of Emergency Management Services in Tamil Nadu under the Public Private Partnership Scheme. A Memorandum of Understanding (MOU) with the Emergency Management Research Institute (EMRI), Hyderabad was signed on 06.05.2008 and the services were put into operation on 15.09.2008. 108 – Ambulance Service is operational in this State to provide emergency ambulance service to transport the victim to the appropriate hospital. To provide the service under PPP mode, centralized system of operation was adopted.

2. In Government Order second read above, the GVK Emergency Management Research Institute (EMRI) has been permitted to extend their services for a further period of five years from 05.05.2013 and an Memorandum of Understanding was signed between Government of Tamil Nadu and GVK Emergency Management Research Institute (EMRI) on 31.07.2013.

3. The Project Director, Tamil Nadu Health Systems Project has stated that now the service is in operational successfully with the fleet strength of 950 across the State, covering all terrain areas. The extended period of 5 years shall also come to an end on 04.05.2018

4. The Project Director, Tamil Nadu Health Systems Project has stated that regarding the course of continuance of 108 - Ambulance Service after 04.05.2018, a meeting was conducted on 09.03.2018 and 14.03.2018 next round of meeting is also proposed.

5. The Project Director, Tamil Nadu Health Systems Project has stated that the Director, GVK Emergency Management Research Institute (EMRI) has sent a letter dated 16.03.2018, revising their National Administrative Costs from their initial quote of 10% to 9% of the actual operational expenses incurred for integrated operations of all services under the Memorandum of Understanding. As already explained in their aforesaid letter, the National Administrative oversight costs are attributable towards leadership, Project monitoring, protocol and process implementation, innovations and research & Development activities payable to the Headquarters.

6. The Project Director, Tamil Nadu Health Systems Project has requested the Government to permit the Project Director to extend the service for minimum period of six months or until a final decision is taken on the contract in this regard as the Memorandum of Understanding is expiring on 04.05.2018 and 108 Ambulance Service is an Emergency service.

7. The Government have examined the proposal carefully and accordingly, the Government direct that the Emergency Ambulance Services implemented vide Government Order read above, be extended for a further period of Six months with effect from 05.05.2018 with the same service provider with the existing terms and conditions in the Memorandum of Understanding.
