ORDER:

In the G.O first read above orders were issued sanctioning a sum of Rs.1,21,50,000/- (Rupees One crore twenty one lakhs and fifty thousand only) at the rate of Rs.2.36/- lakhs per course for 25 Post Graduate courses, towards application fees payable to the Medical Council of India, New Delhi, Rs.2.52/- lakhs per course for 20 new courses and Rs.2.42/- lakhs per course for 5 courses for increase of seats, towards affiliation fees payable to the Tamil Nadu Dr.MGR Medical University, Chennai.

2. In his letter second read above the Director of Medical Education, has stated that the Board of Governors In Supersession of Medical Council of India / Medical Council of India has issued an amendment notification dated 04.04.2019 for enhancing the existing Post Graduate Teacher: Student ratio as detailed below:
