ORDER:

National Florence Nightingale Nurses Awards are given as a mark of recognition for the meritorious services rendered by Nursing Professionals in the country. This award is presented on 12th of May every year on the occasion of the birth anniversary of Florence Nightingale. The award is given to outstanding Nursing personnel employed in Central, State/UTs, Private, Missionary and Voluntary Organizations. The awards consists of Cash Award of Rs.50,000/- a certificate and a Medal.

2. In this connection, the Indian Nursing Council has prescribed a State Level Selection Committee comprising of the following members:-

1. Secretary, Health & Family Welfare - Chairman
2. Director of Health Services / Director
of Medical Education - Member
3. Registrar/ Representative, State
Nursing Council - Member
4. President/ Secretary, T.N.A.I.(State
Branch / State level nursing Association - Member
5. Chief Nurse in the Office of Directorate
of Health Services(ADHS Nursing /
Deputy Director Nursing) - Member Secretary

3. The Indian Nursing Council has further requested to follow the following important aspects while forwarding the nominations:-

- i. Wide publicity may be given in the State to all the concerned Stakeholders by issuing necessary circulars and up-loading the enclosed documents on the official website of the State Government.
- ii. It may be ensured that applications for the nominations are received from Private and Missionary institution also apart from Government institutions.
- iii. Representatives of the Trained Nurses Association of India (TNAI) at the State Level or Associations should be included in the Selection Committee.
- iv. It should be ensured that the panel of names should include nominations in each of the three categories i.e. Nurses, Auxiliary Nurse Midwives and Lady Health Visitors.
- v. It should be ensured that only such candidates are nominated who fulfill the criteria and proven evidence of outstanding work in their field and all the nominations are to be placed before the State Selection Committee meeting.

4. In the above circumstances, the Government after careful examination decided to constitute a State Level Selection Committee comprises with the following members:-
