**Order:**

In his letter second read above, the Director of Medical Education has stated, among others that in G.O.(Ms) No.230, Health and Family Welfare Department, dated 12.08.2014 orders were issued for increase of stipend to CRRIs and Non-Service Post Graduate Degree / Diploma and Higher Speciality (DM/M.Ch.) students with effect from 01.04.2014 as detailed below and also ordered that an automatic increase of Rs.400/- for CRRIs and Rs.700/- for Post Graduate Degree/Diploma and Higher Speciality students every year;

2. He has also stated that Tamil Nadu ranks first in Health Care Services and the stipend sanctioned to the CRRIs and Non-Service Post Graduate Degree/Diploma and Higher Speciality (DM/M.Ch) students are less compared to that of other neighbouring States. In fine, he has requested the Government to take a decision on the enhancement of stipend to the CRRIs students/Post Graduate Degree/Diploma and Higher Speciality students and to issue necessary orders.

3. The Government, after careful examination, have decided to enhance the rate of stipend to the CRRIs, Post Graduate Degree/Diploma and Higher Speciality students including M.Ch (Neuro Surgery - 6 year course) students from 01.04.2018. The Government accordingly do and hereby direct that the rate of stipend to the CRRIs, Post Graduate Degree/Diploma and Higher Speciality students including M.Ch (Neuro Surgery – 6 years course) students be enhanced the stipend with effect from 01.04.2018 as follows;

4. The Government also direct that an automatic annual increase of Rs.600/- for Compulsory Rotatory Residential Internees (CRRIs) and Rs.1000/- for Post Graduate/Higher Speciality students be sanctioned.

5. The expenditure sanctioned in paras 3 and 4 above shall be debited in the following head of account:-

2210 Medical and Public Health - 05 Medical Education, Training and Research - 105 Allopathy / State's Expenditures - AL Improvements to Medical Colleges - 12 Scholarships and Stipends - 09 Others.

6. Necessary additional funds of Rs.44,17,58,600/- sanctioned in paras 3 and 4 above will be provided in the Revised Estimate / Final Modified Appropriation 2018-2019 to meet the above expenditure. However, the expenditure shall be brought to the notice of the Legislature by specific inclusion in the supplementary Estimate 2018-2019. Pending provision of such funds, the Director of Medical Education, Chennai is authorized to draw and disburse the amount and he is requested to include the above expenditure while sending the budget proposal for Revised Estimate / Final Modified Appropriation 2018-2019 and also to send necessary explanatory notes to Finance (BG-I) Department for inclusion of the above expenditure in the supplementary Estimates 2018-2019.

7. This order issues with the concurrence of the Finance Department vide its U.O.No.189/Secy(Expr)/2018, Dated 25.07.2018 and with ASL No.813 (Eight hundred and thirteen).
