ORDER:

In the Government Order first read above, among other things, orders were issued, forming a new Department called Tamil Nadu Food Safety and Drug Administration Department. In the above Government order, a sum of Rs. 2,45,00,000 (Rupees Two Crores and Forty Five Lakhs only) has been sanctioned for purchase of vehicle to the Commissionerate of Food Safety and Drug Administration, Head Quarters and District Level Function.

2. In the Government Order second read above, permission was granted for purchase of the following vehicles for the use of Officers of Tamil Nadu Food Safety and Drug Administration Department at the rates mentioned against them:-

3. The Commissioner of Food Safety and Drug Administration Department has stated that the 31 vehicles got billed and one vehicle was pending for a long time due to a short payment. This vehicle also got billed for Designated Officer, Vellore. The Central Government has enhanced the Basic excise duty rates for vehicles falling under SUV categories from 27% to 30% with effect from 01.03.2013 and requested to settle the balance cost of Rs.67.213/-

4. In the letter third read above, the Commissioner, Food Safety and Drug Administration Department has requested the Government to sanction the following additional amount due to the enhancement of Basic Excise duty rates from 27% to 30% with effect from 01.03.2013:-

5. The Government have carefully examined the proposal of the Commissioner, Tamil Nadu Food Safety and Drug Administration Department and decided to accept the same and accordingly sanction an additional amount of Rs. 67,213/- (Rupees sixty seven thousand two hundred and thirteen only) in connection with the purchase of vehicles sanctioned in the G.O. second cited, to meet the enhanced basic Excise duty.

6. The expenditure sanctioned in para 5 above shall be debited to the following Head of Account:-

7. The amount sanctioned in para 5 above will be provided in RE/FMA 2014 - 2015. Pending provision of funds in Revised Estimate / Final Modified Appropriation 2014 - 2015. The Commissioner of Food Safety and Drug Administration is authorized to draw and disburse the amount. The Commissioner of Food Safety and Drug Administration is directed to include this expenditure while sending proposal for Revised Estimate / Final Modified Appropriation 2014 – 2015 to Government in Finance (Health-I) Department without fail.
