ORDER:

Dr. D. Rajesh, Tiruppur District is working as Assistant Surgeon in Government Hospital, Periyanaikanpalayam, Tiruppur District has requested financial assistance of sum of Rs.27.5 lakh for his Baby Jishnu, a case of Infant B cell Acute Lymphoblastic Leukemia under treatment in CMC Vellore.

2. The Project Director, Tamil Nadu Health Systems Project has stated that since Dr.D.Rajesh F/o. Baby. Jishnu is an employee under the Government of Tamil Nadu, he is not eligible to enroll under Chief Minister's Comprehensive Health Insurance Scheme. Hence the treatment of Baby. Jishnu could not be covered under Chief Minister's Comprehensive Health Insurance Scheme and requested the Government to issue special orders to give Allogenic unrelated BMT approval under Chief Minister's Comprehensive Health Insurance Scheme for Baby. Jishnu.

3. The Government have examined the request of the individual, under the emergent nature and the health condition of the Baby. Jishnu and sanction a sum of Rs.27.5 lakh (Rupees Twenty seven lakh and fifty thousand only) to Baby. Jishnu as a special case for the Allogenic Peripheral Blood Stem Cell Transplantation, since the petitioner has already claimed an amount of Rs.7,50,000/- under Government employees New Health Insurance Scheme.

4. The expenditure sanctioned in paragraph 3 above shall be debited under the following head of account:

2210 Medical and Public Health 01 Urban Health Services – Allopathy –
110 Hospitals and Dispensaries – State's Expenditure – AC Non Taluk
Headquarters Hospitals – 01 Salaries 03 Medical Charges

5. The expenditure sanctioned in para 3 above shall constitute an item of " New Instrument of Service" and the approval of Legislature will be obtained in due course. Pending approval of the Legislature, the expenditure may be initially met by drawal of an advance from the Contingency Fund. The Director of Medical and Rural Health Services is directed to calculate the actual amount required for the period upto next Supplementary Estimates and apply for action of the same as advance from the Contingency Fund to Finance (BG.I) Department directly in Form " A" appended to the Tamil Nadu Contingency Fund Rules 1963 along with a copy of this order. Orders for sanction of an advance from the Contingency Fund will be issued from Finance (BG.I) Department. The Director of Medical and Rural Health Services is requested to send necessary explanatory notes to include the above expenditure in the Supplementary Estimates for the year 2018-2019 to Finance (BG-I) Department at the appropriate time without fail.
